ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Caledonian Canal, Corpach Locks and Basin comprises the sea lock, basin and two locks at the western end of the Caledonian Canal, together with associated working areas. The lighthouse is included in the scheduling, but the modern lock gates and hydraulic control gear are excluded. The area to be scheduled is irregularly shaped, a maximum of 440m by 80m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilmallie and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

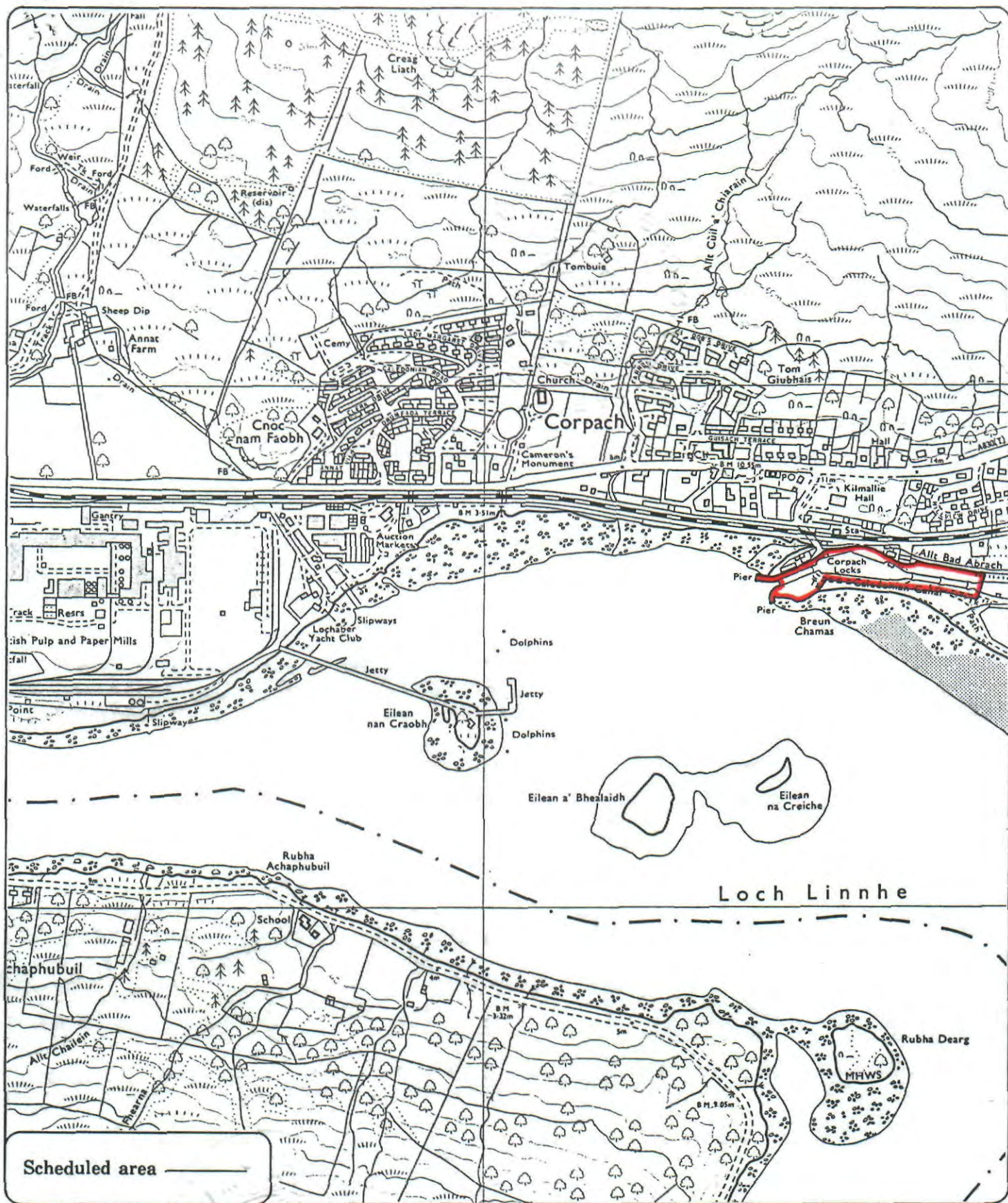

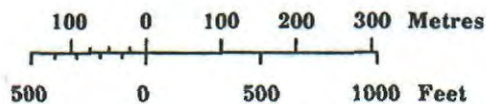
**Caledonian Canal, Corpach
