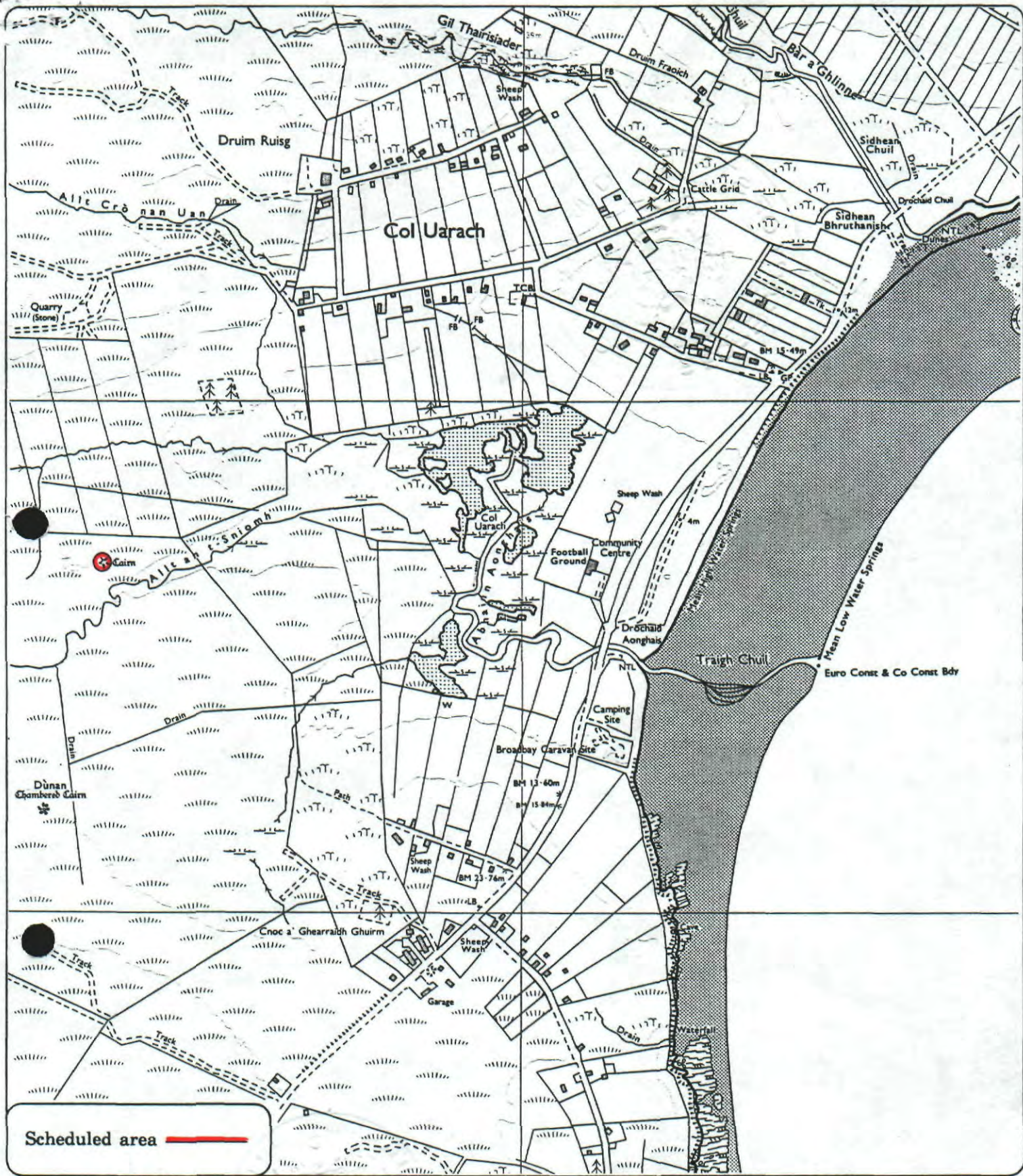

Scheduled area

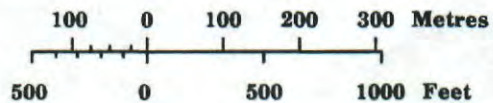
Allt an-t-Sniomh, chambered
