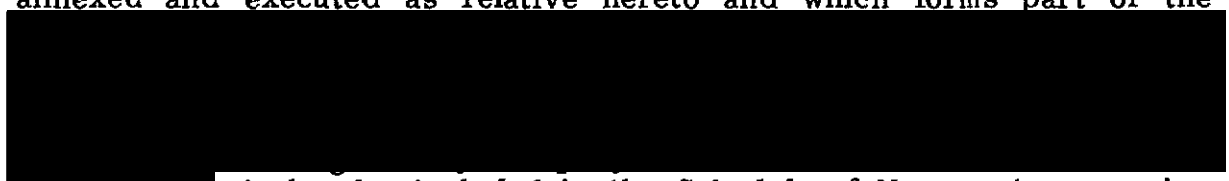

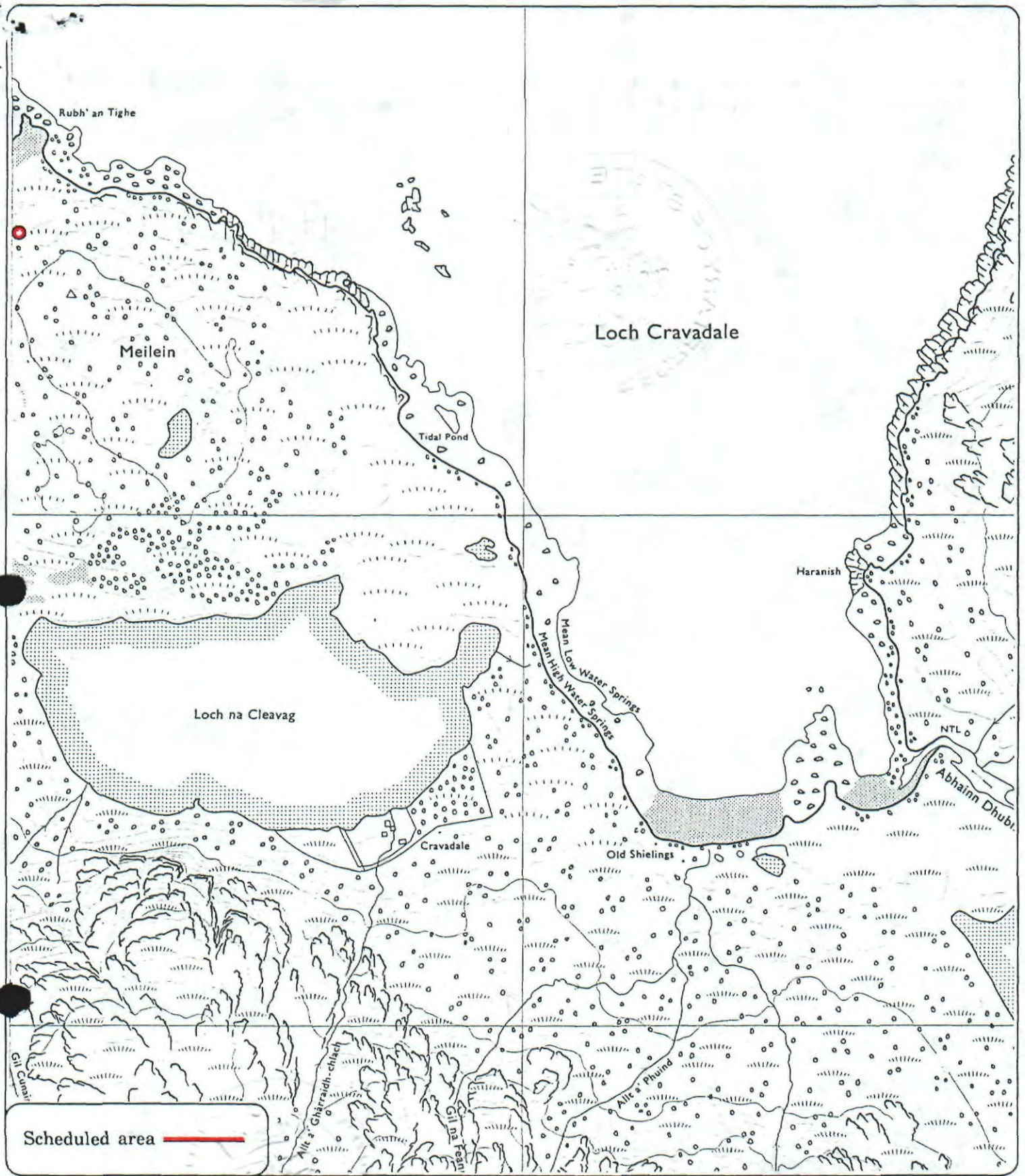

Scheduled area 

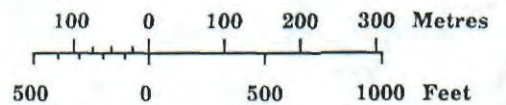
