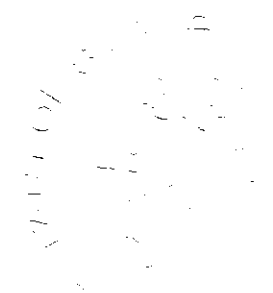

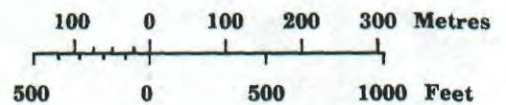
Loch Raoinavat, stone circle
