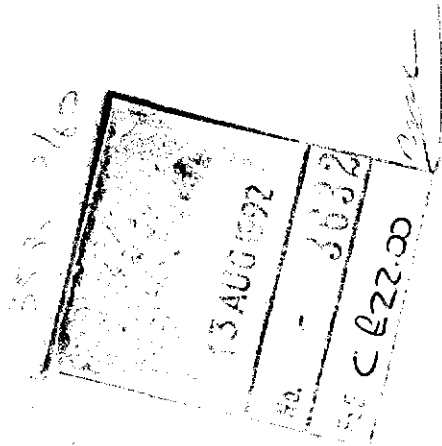

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as St Columb's Church, Eilean Chaluim Chille comprises the remains of a single chambered early mediaeval church within a burial ground. The area to be scheduled is irregular and measures a maximum of 30m N-S by 30m E-W to include the Church and burial ground. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Lochs and the County of Ross and Cromarty as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the

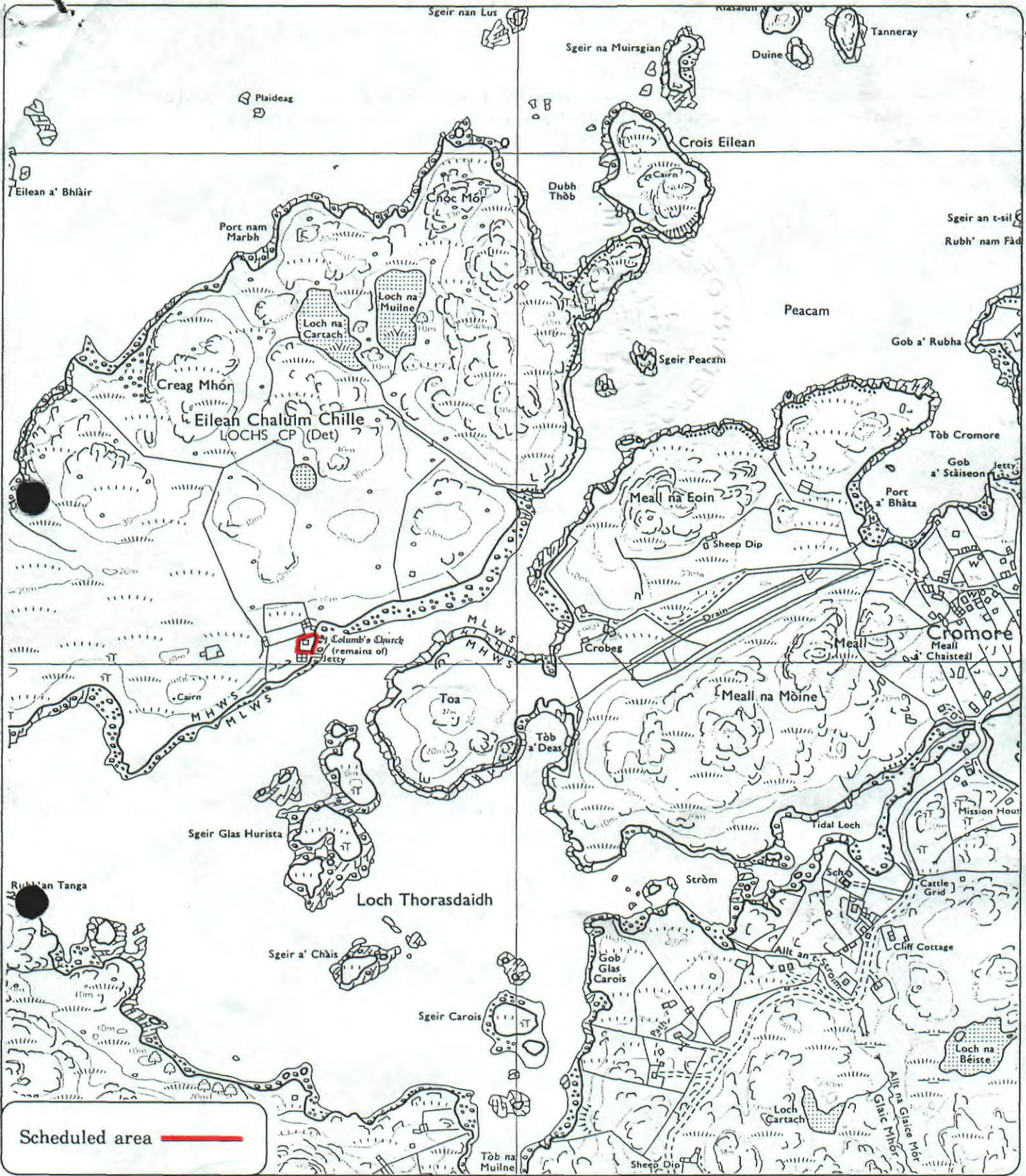

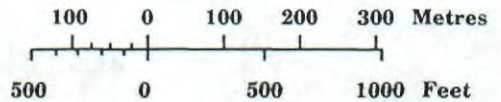
