ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Caisteal Mhic Creacail, chambered cairn, Fleisirin comprises of the disturbed remains of a chambered cairn constructed during the Neolithic period (c.3800-2000BC). The area to be scheduled is irregular, measuring a maximum of 120m N-S by 90m E-W to include the cairn and a surrounding area which may contain archaeological evidence associated with the construction and use of the site. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Stornoway and the County of Ross and Cromarty as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects described in the

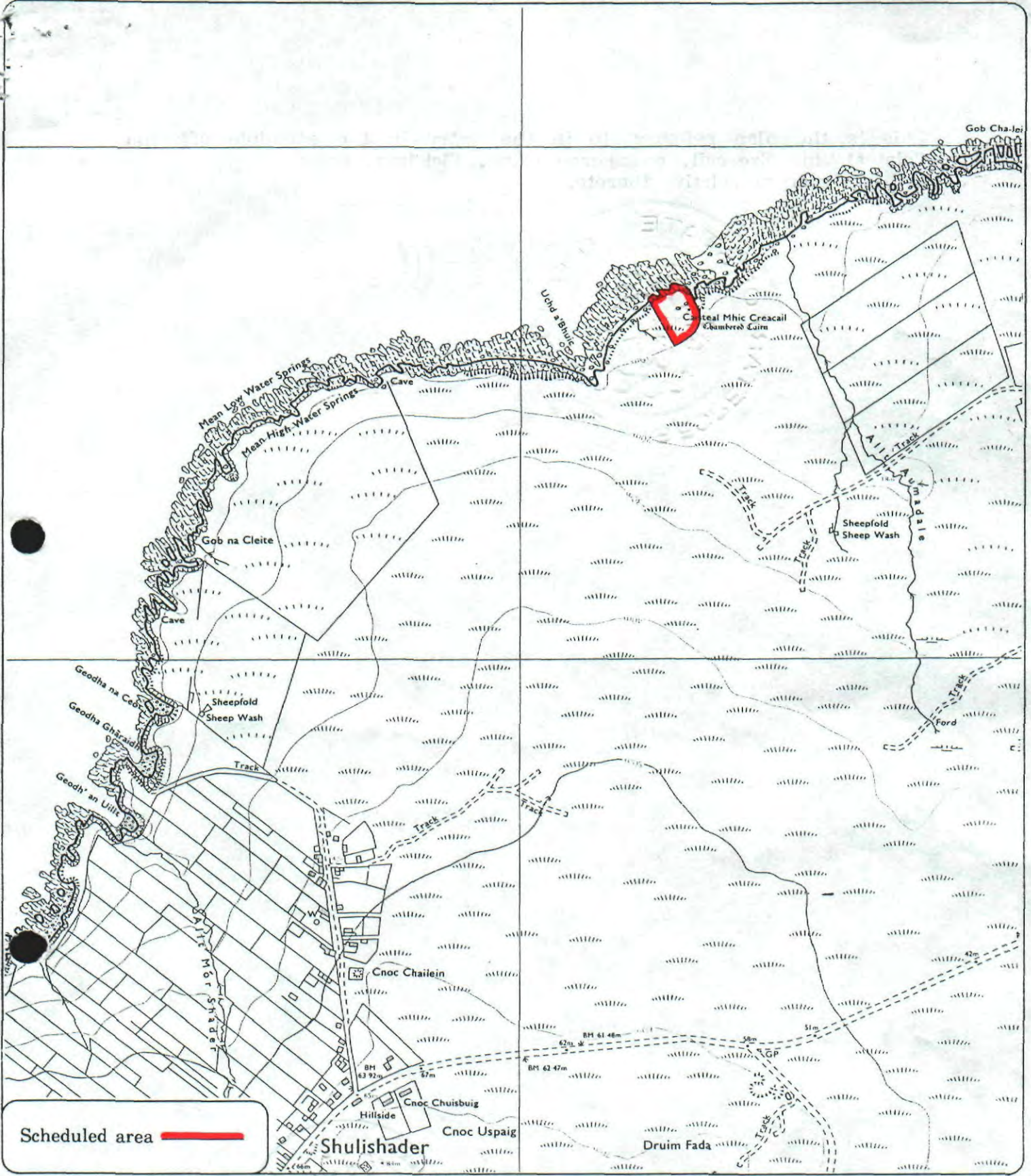

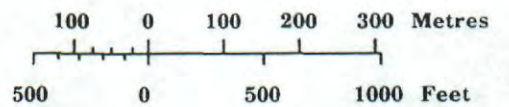
