The monument known as Coire na Feinne, chambered cairn comprises the remains of a chambered cairn of Neolithic date known as Coire na Feinne. The area to be scheduled is a quadrilateral, measuring a maximum of 12m NW-SE by 10m transversely, excluding the road to the North of the monument. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Harris and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects



hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

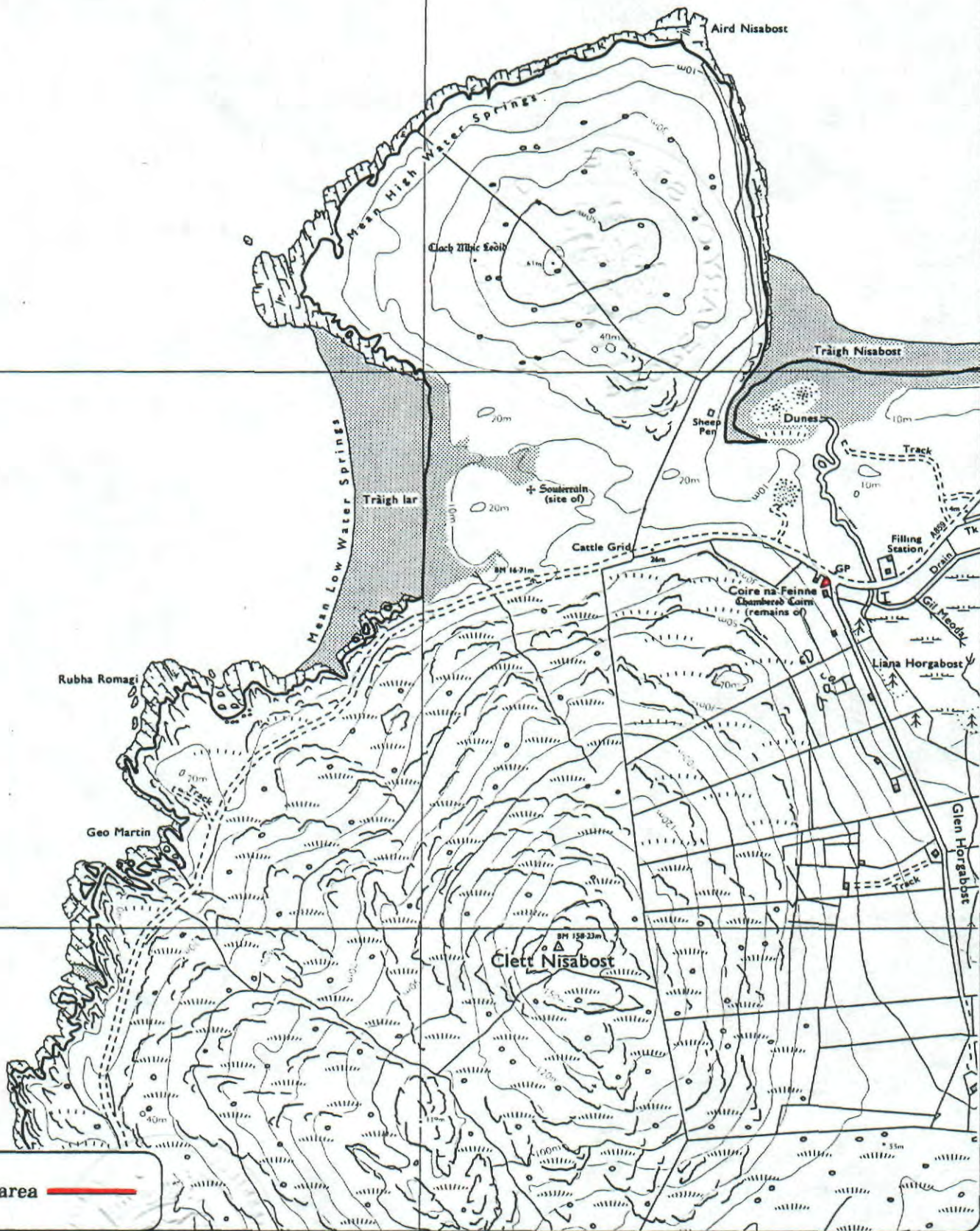

Scheduled area 

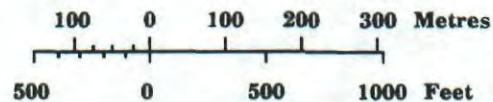
Coire na Feinne,
