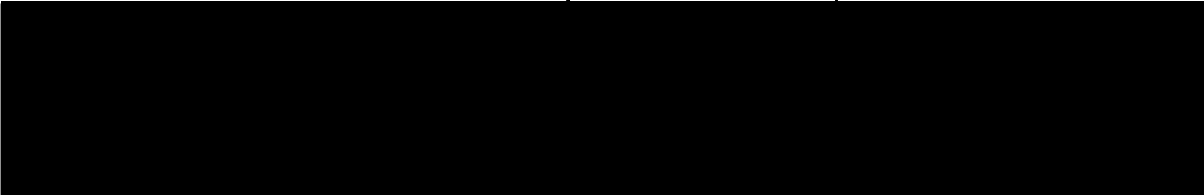

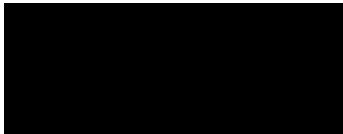
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979

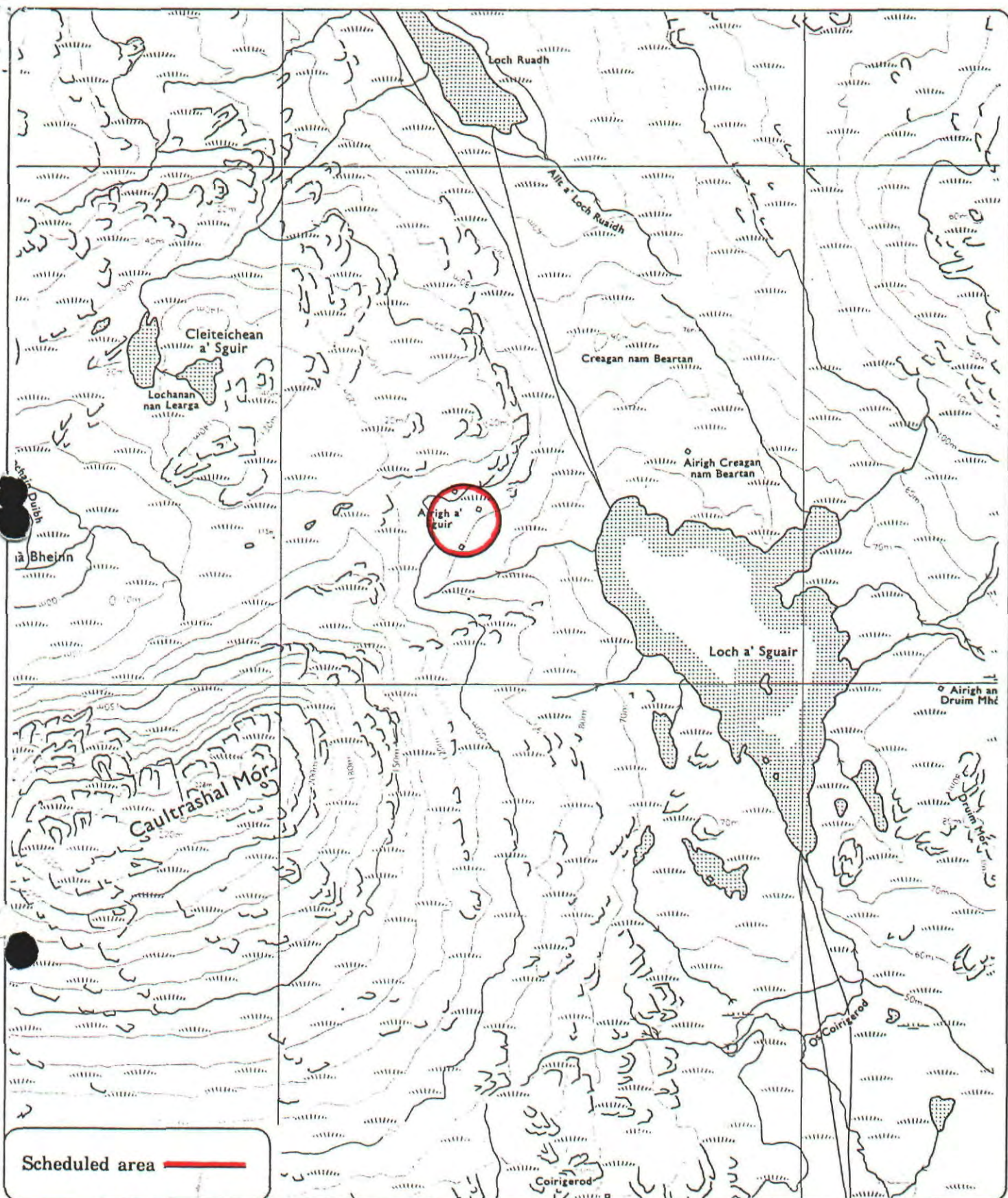




**Airigh a'Sguir, beehive shielings**
