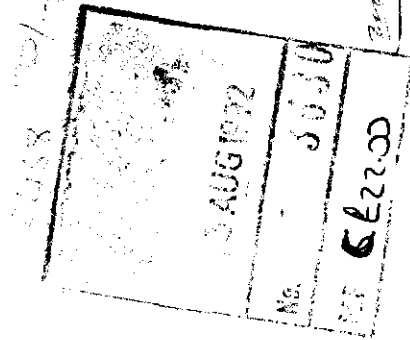

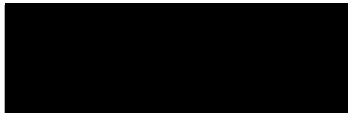
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Teampull Ronaidh, chapel comprises the remains of a chapel called Teampull Ronaidh. The area to be scheduled is square with sides measuring a maximum of 20m, to be centred on the chapel. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Barvas and the County of Ross and Cromarty as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects described in the



hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

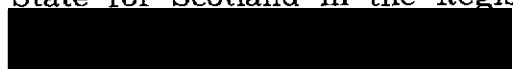

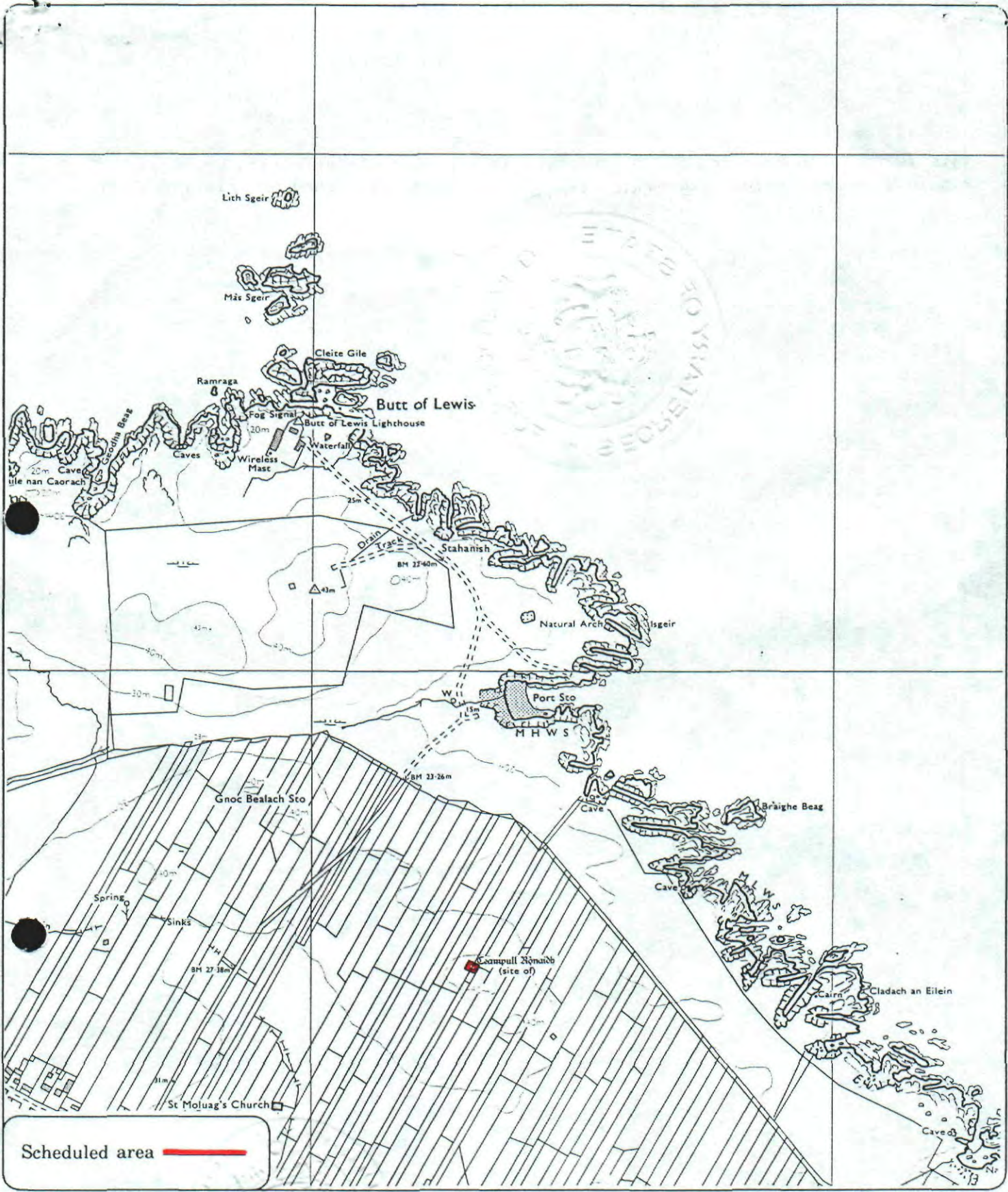

Scheduled area

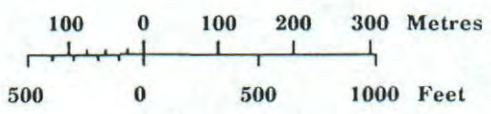
Teampull Ronaidd, chapel
