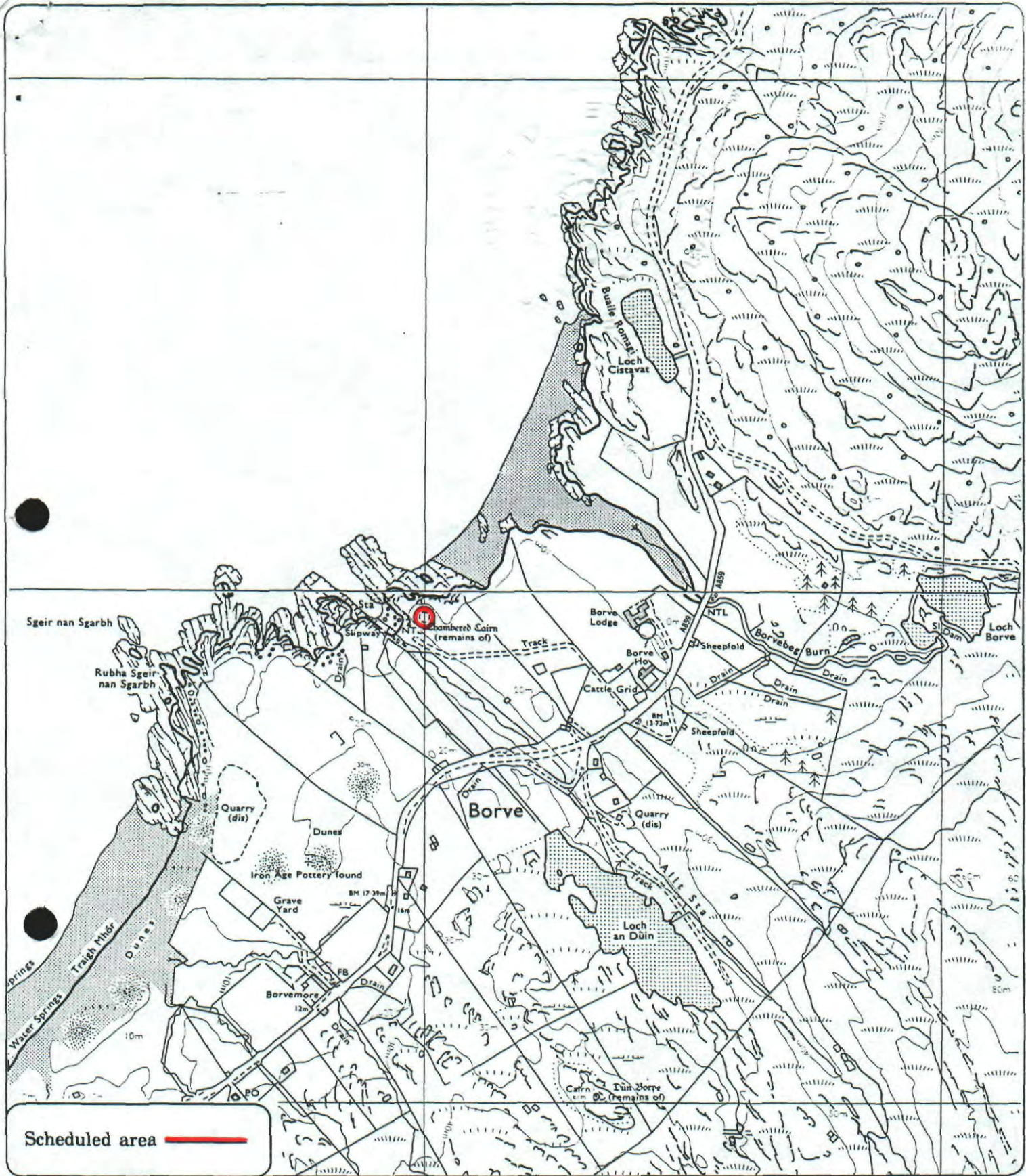

Scheduled area

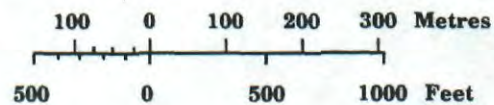
**Borve Lodge, chambered cairn**
