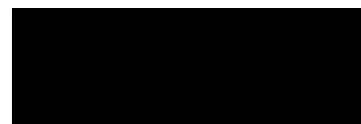

The monument known as Dursainean, chambered cairn, Garrabost comprises the remains of a chambered cairn constructed during the Neolithic period. The area to be scheduled is circular with a maximum diameter of 40m to include the cairn and an area surrounding it which may contain evidence of activity related to its construction and use. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Stornoway and the County of Ross and Cromarty as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects described in the
