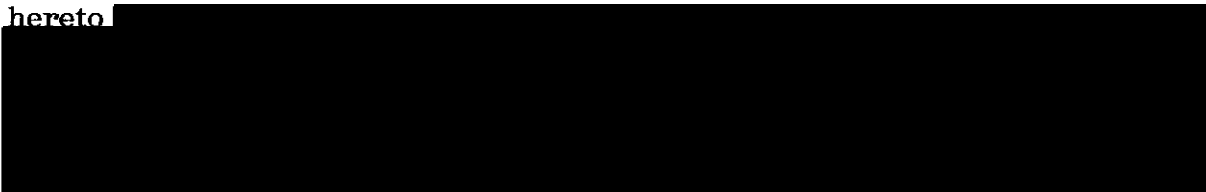

The monument known as Clach Stein, standing stones, Knockaird comprises of two standing stones situated on top of a hill overlooking Port of Ness from the NW. These are most likely of Bronze Age date. The area to be scheduled is circular, centred on the mid-point between the standing stones, and has a maximum diameter of 10m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Barvas and the County of Ross and Cromarty as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

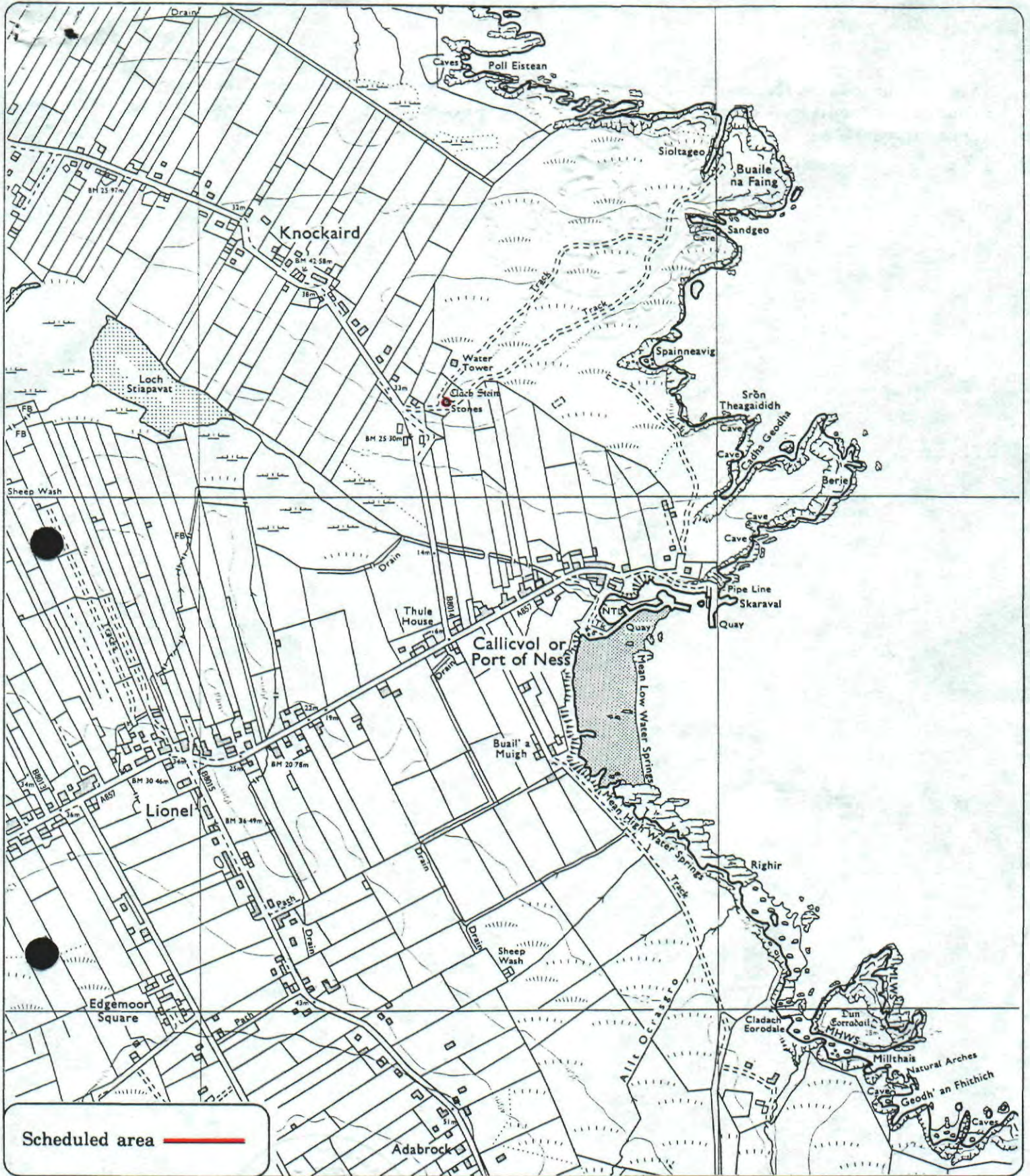
