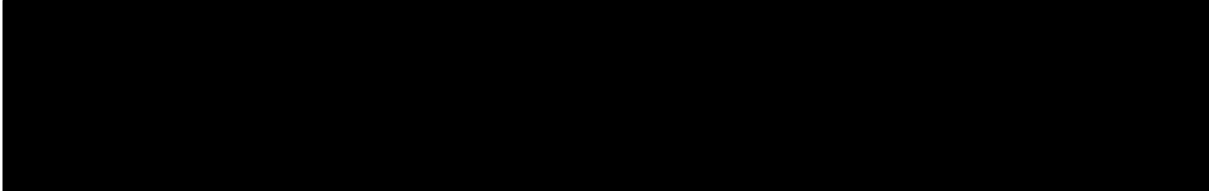

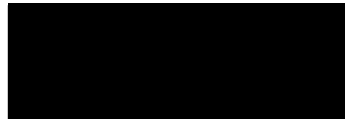

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Tigh a'Bheannaich, chapel, Aird Uig comprises of the remains of a small chapel of simple construction called, "Tigh a'Bheannaich" (Blessing House). The area to be scheduled is square with sides measuring a maximum of 26m to include the chapel and an area surrounding it which may contain evidence for activity associated with its use and construction. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Uig and the County of Ross and Cromarty as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the

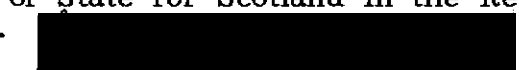

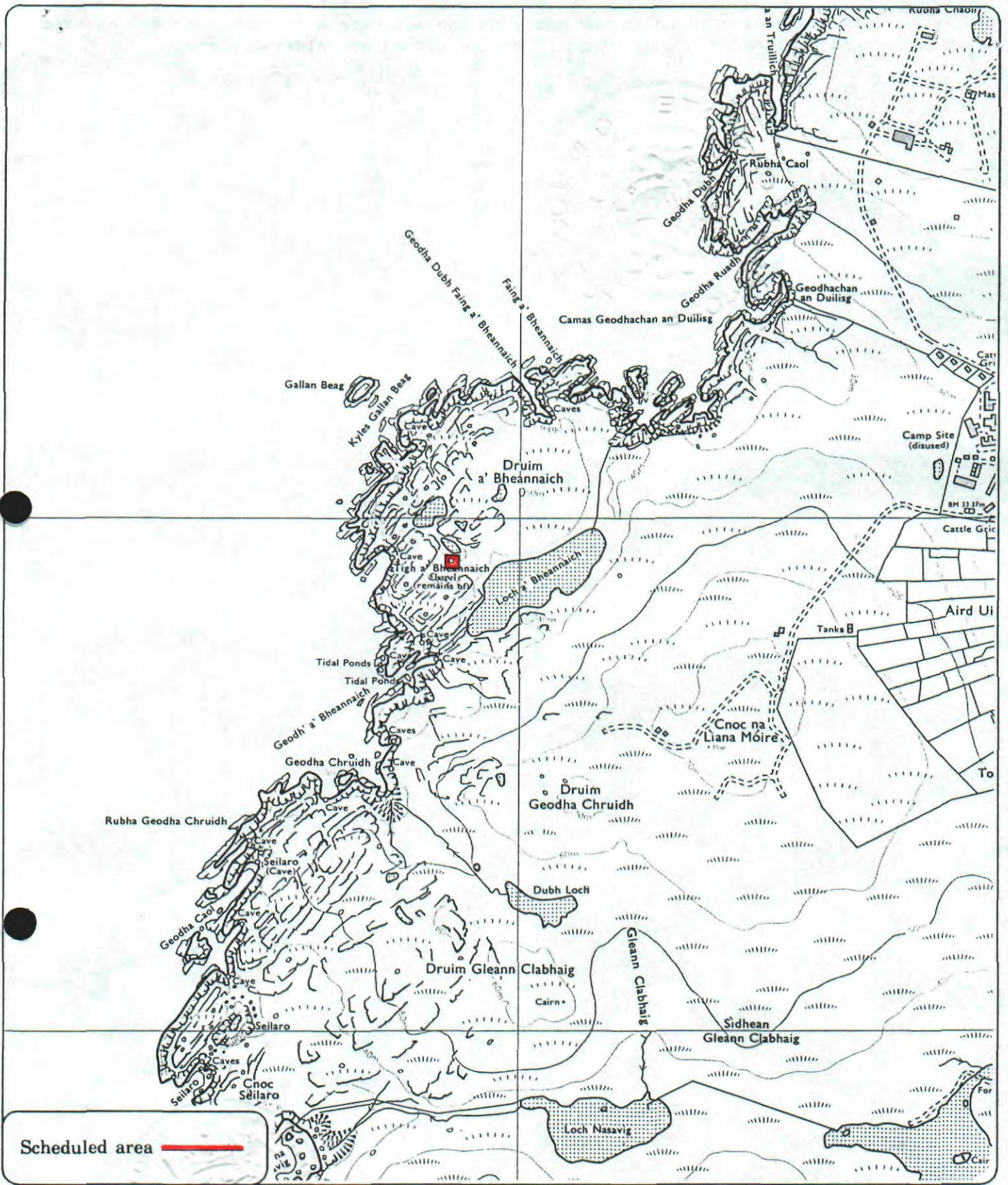
