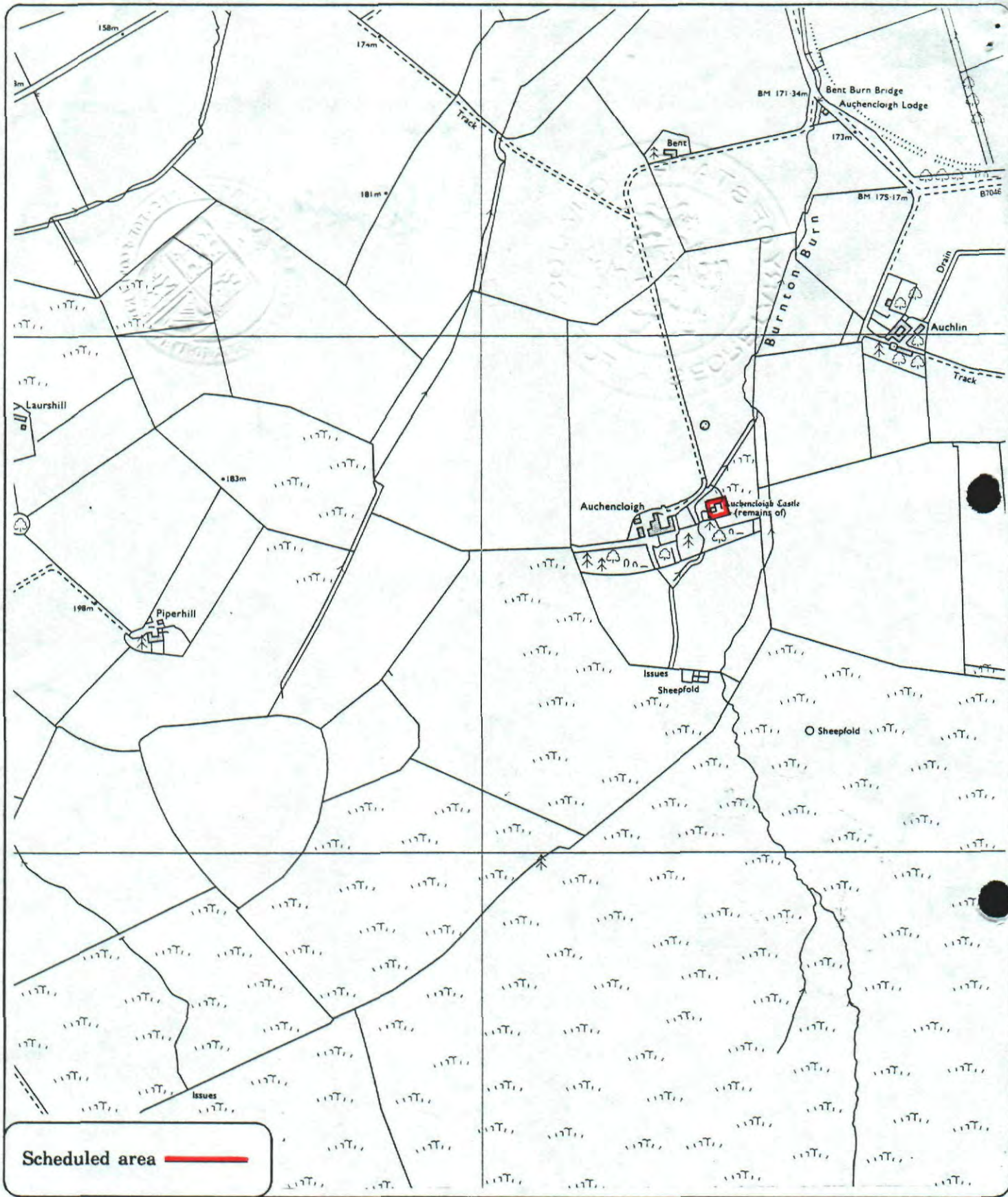

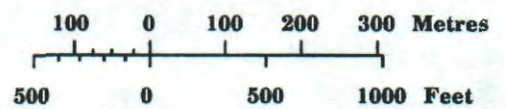
**Auchenloigh Castle**
