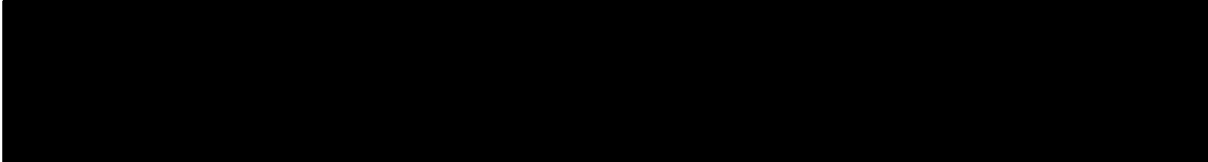

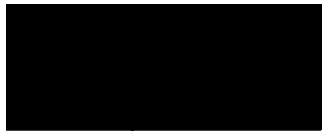
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Caledonian Canal, Dochgarroch Lock comprises a standard masonry-walled Caledonian Canal lock, with associated working areas. The area to be scheduled is roughly rectangular, 100m SW-NE by 45m NW-SE. The modern lock gates and hydraulic control gear are excluded from the scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Inverness and Bona and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

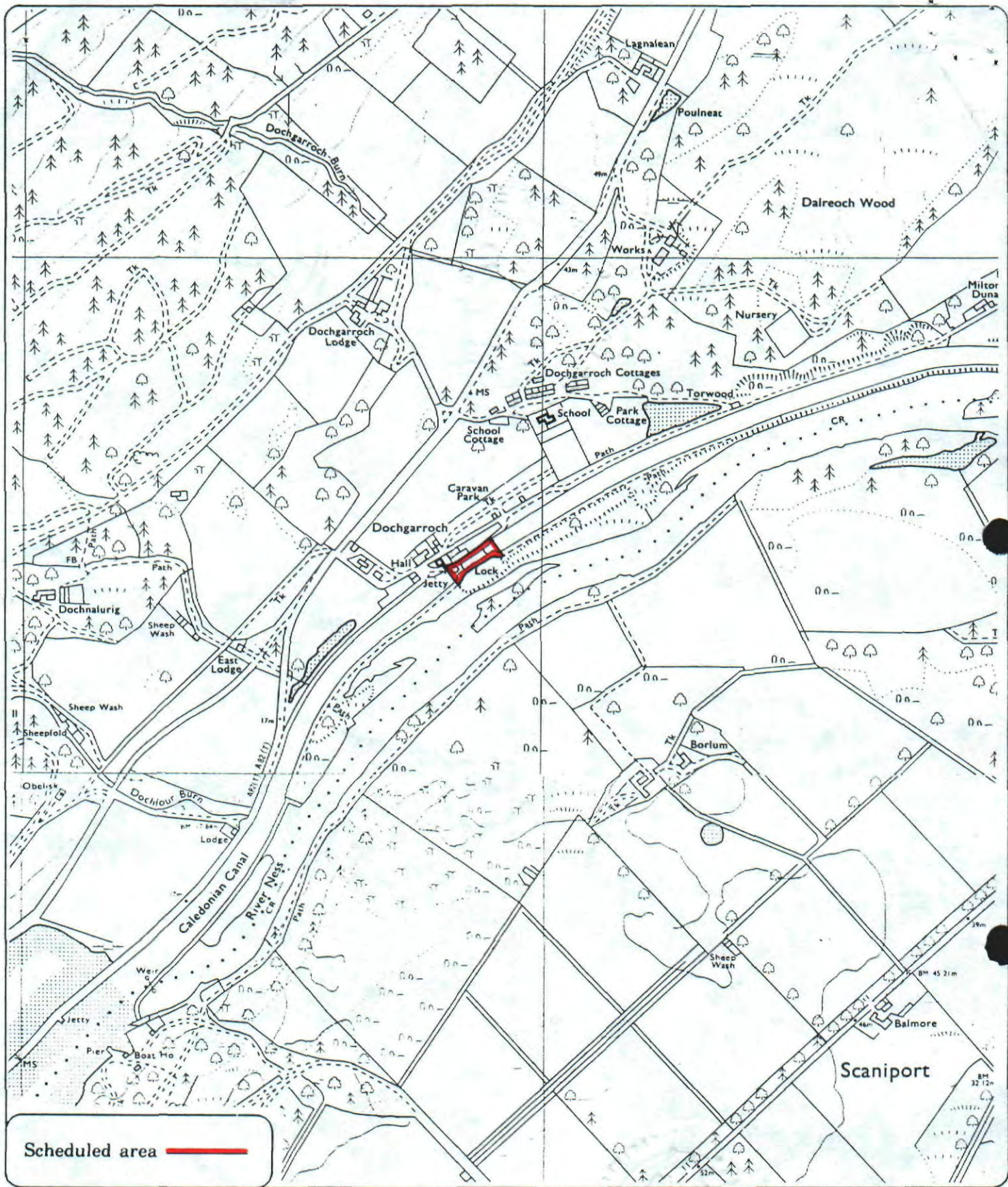

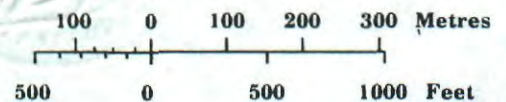
Caledonian Canal, Dochgarroch Lock
