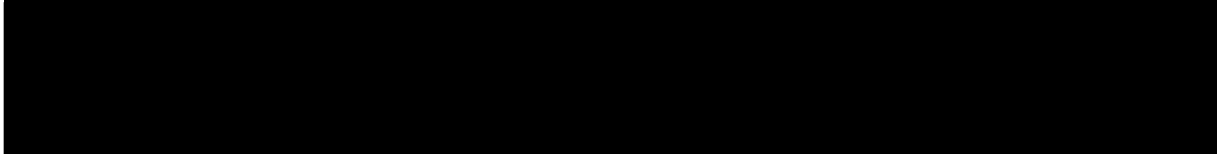

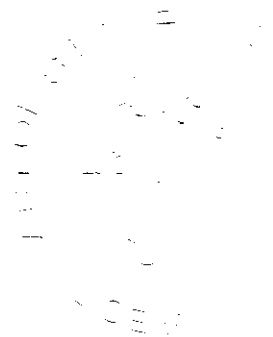
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Airigh Mhaoldonuich, fallen standing stone comprises a very large standing stone, now fallen, and its setting. The area to be scheduled is a rectangle 25m N-S by 38m E-W, bounded on the W by the E side of a private track. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Uig and the County of Ross and Cromarty as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

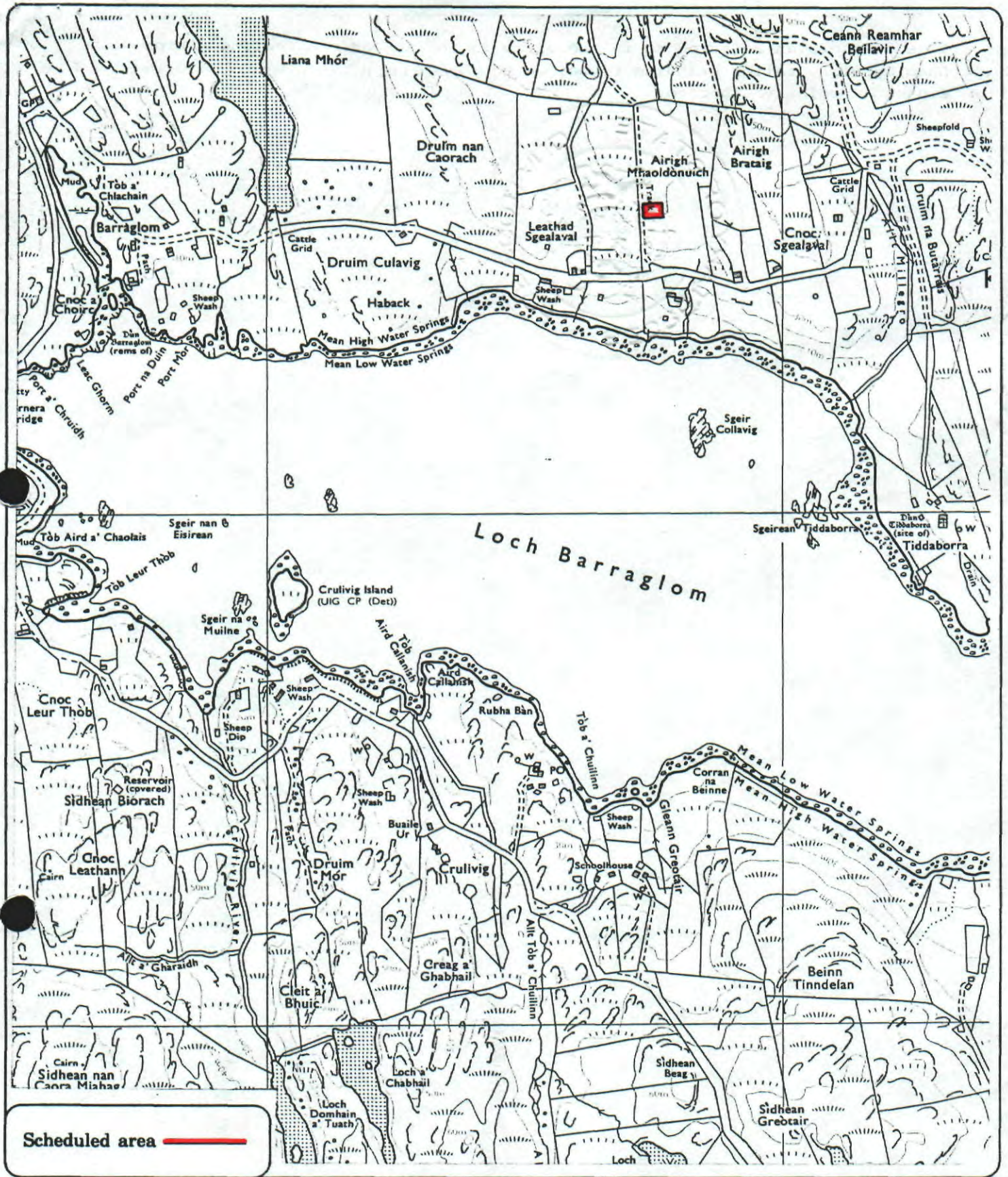

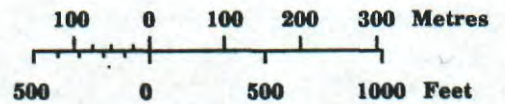
Airigh Mhaoldonuich, fallen standing stone
