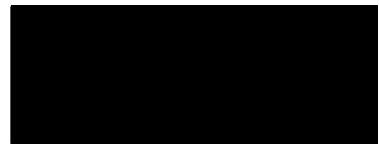
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Flemington Tower, Aberlemno comprises the remains of an L-plan towerhouse of early 17th century date with 18th century modification. The area to be scheduled is rectilinear, measuring a maximum of 20m NNW-SSE by 16m WSW-ENE to be centred on the tower, but excluding the road which delimits the area on the N. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Aberlemno and the County of Angus as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

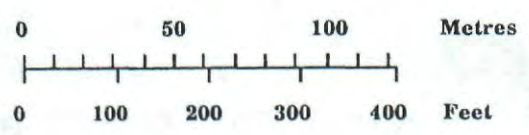
Scheduled area —
