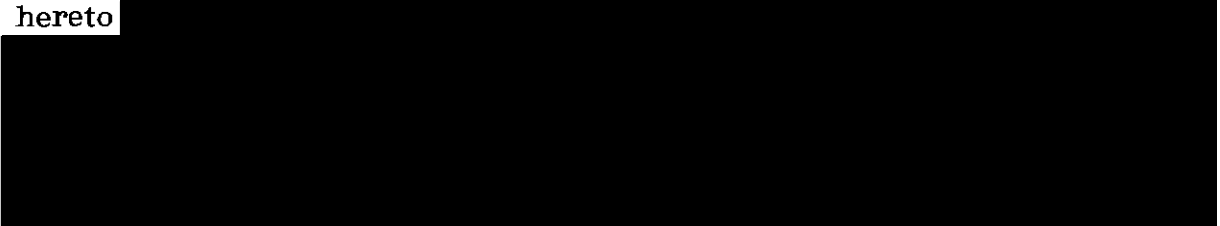

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Rhynd, old parish church 250m SW of Easter Rhynd comprises the remains of the old parish church of Rhynd. The present building, dating from the seventeenth century is likely to overlie the foundations of an earlier church. The area to be scheduled is rectangular to include the above and below ground archaeology of the church, measuring a maximum of 20m ENE-WSW by 15m NNW-SSE. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Rhynd and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

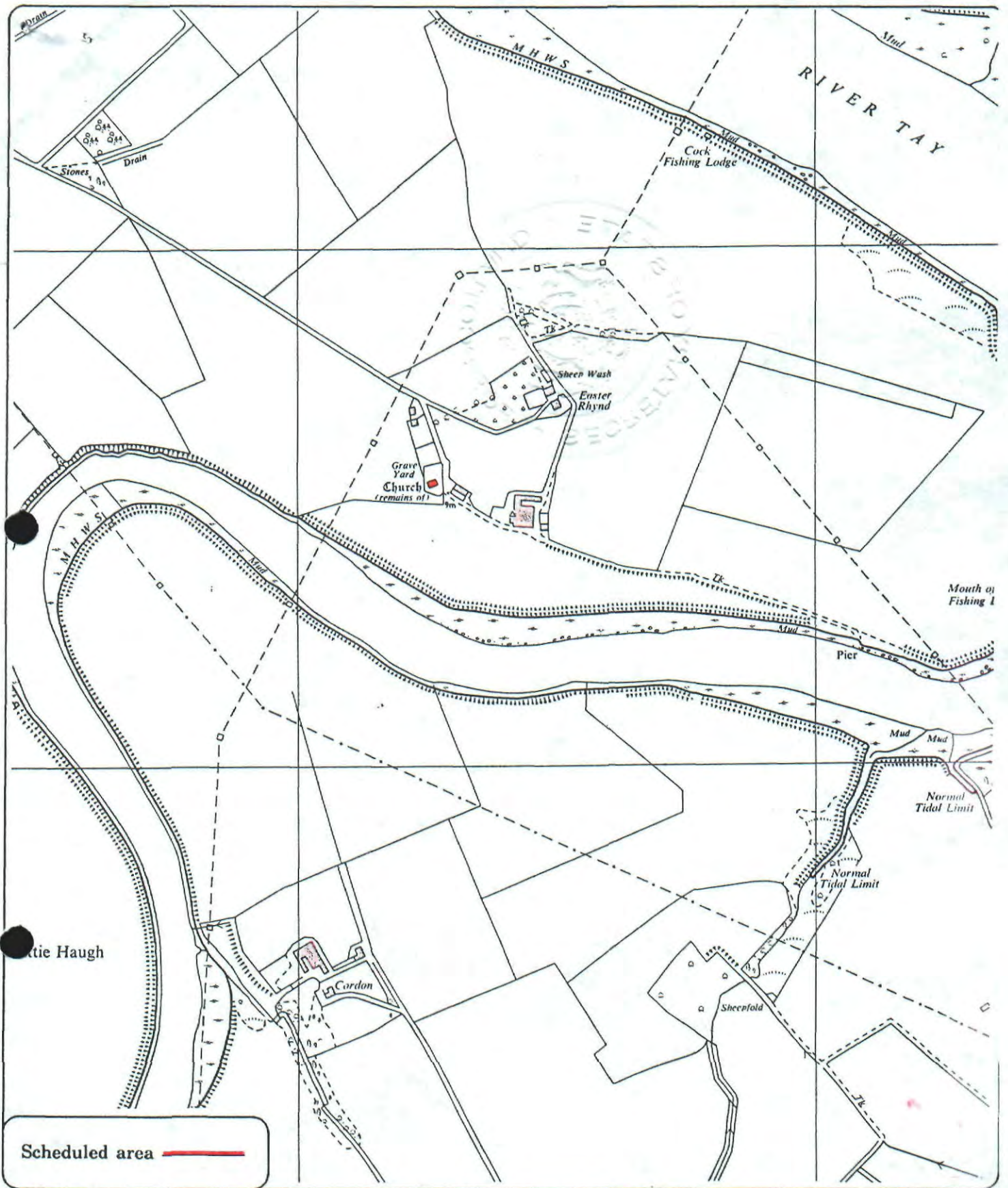


Rhynd, old parish church
