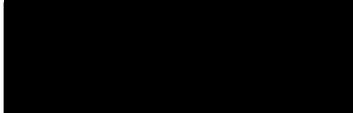

The monument known as Aird Callanish, cairn 200m SW of, Cruilvig comprises a small burial cairn, probably of prehistoric date.
