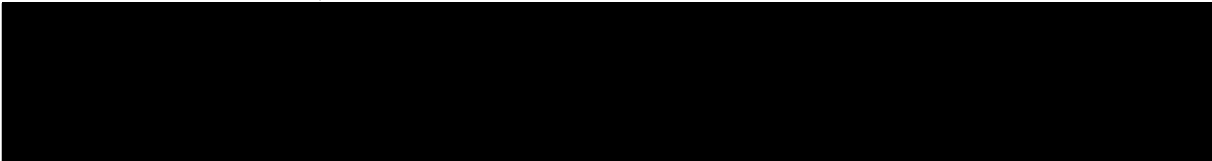

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Rothiemay, St Drostan's Church comprises the remains of the old parish church of Rothiemay which is thought to occupy the site of an early Christian foundation established by St Drostan, Abbot of Deer in Buchan in the sixth century. The area to be scheduled is rectilinear, extending 20m from the exterior walls of the church and measuring a maximum of 63m E-W by 55m N-S. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Rothiemay and the County of Banff as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms



the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

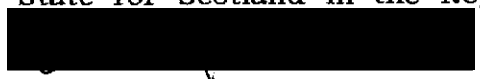

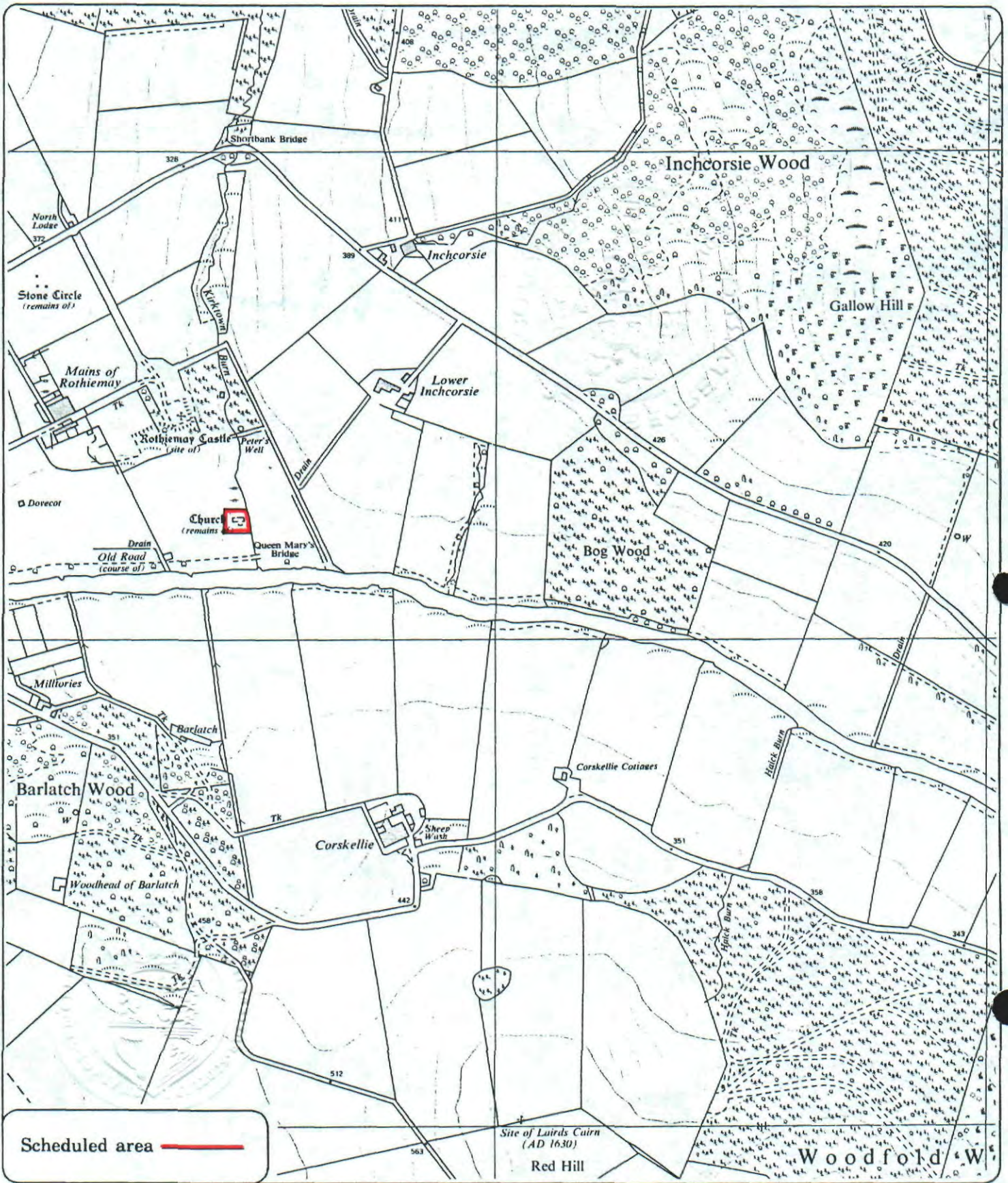

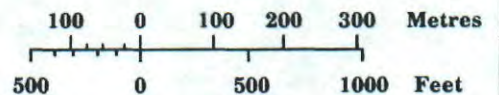
Rothiemay, St. Drostan's Church
