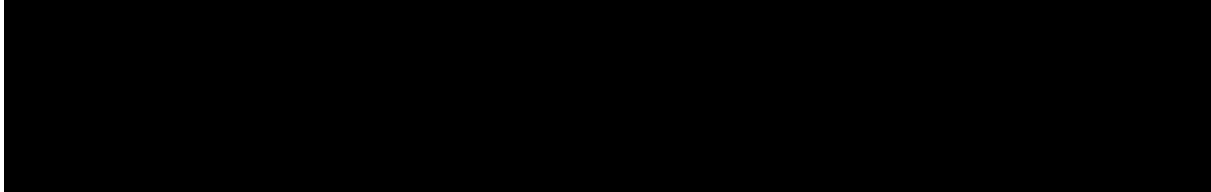

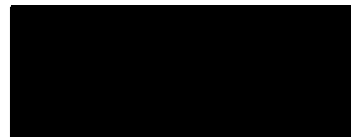
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Invershin Farm, settlement and burnt mound 500m E of comprises a hut circle, a burnt mound and a cairn on a W-facing hill slope. Two areas, about 140m apart are to be scheduled. The S area measures 125m SSW-NNE by 85m NNW-SSE and the N area 60m N-S by 40m E-W, to include the hut circle, cairn, burnt mound and areas around in which traces of activities associated with the construction and use of the monuments may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Creich and the County of Sutherland as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part



in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

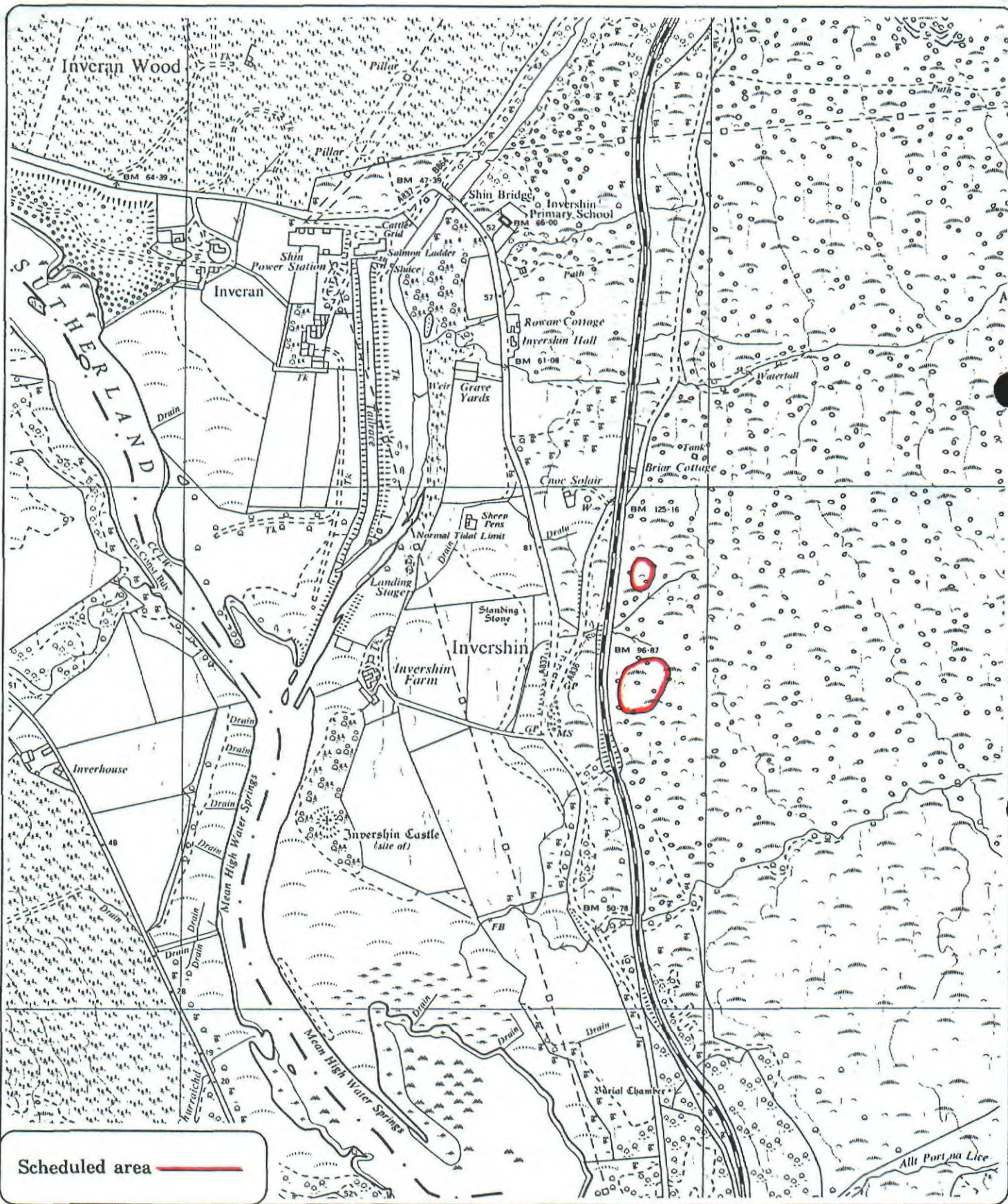

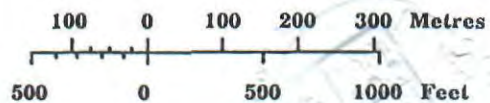
**Invershin Farm, settlement and
