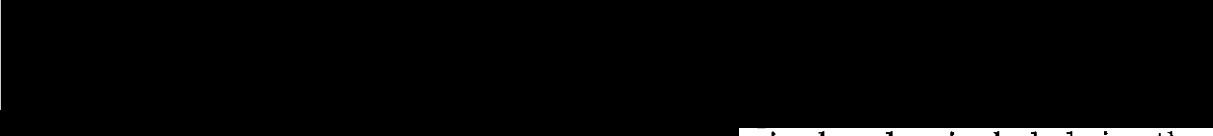

The monument known as Little Loch Borve, cairn 250m SW of comprises remains of a burial cairn of neolithic date (c.4500-2000BC). The area to be scheduled is circular with a maximum diameter of 40m to be centred on the cairn and including an area surrounding the monument which may contain evidence relating to its construction and use. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Harris (Berneray) and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects described in the

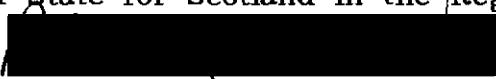
