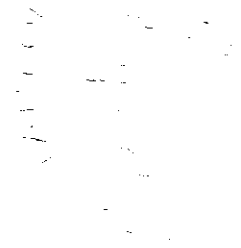

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Clackriach Castle comprises the remains of Clackriach Castle, a small defensive residence of late 16th/early 17th century date. The area to be scheduled is rectangular, measuring a maximum of 20m NE-SW by 10m NW-SE, to include the upstanding portion of the tower and related buried features. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Old Deer and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

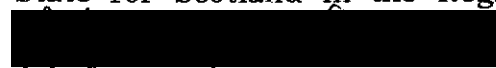

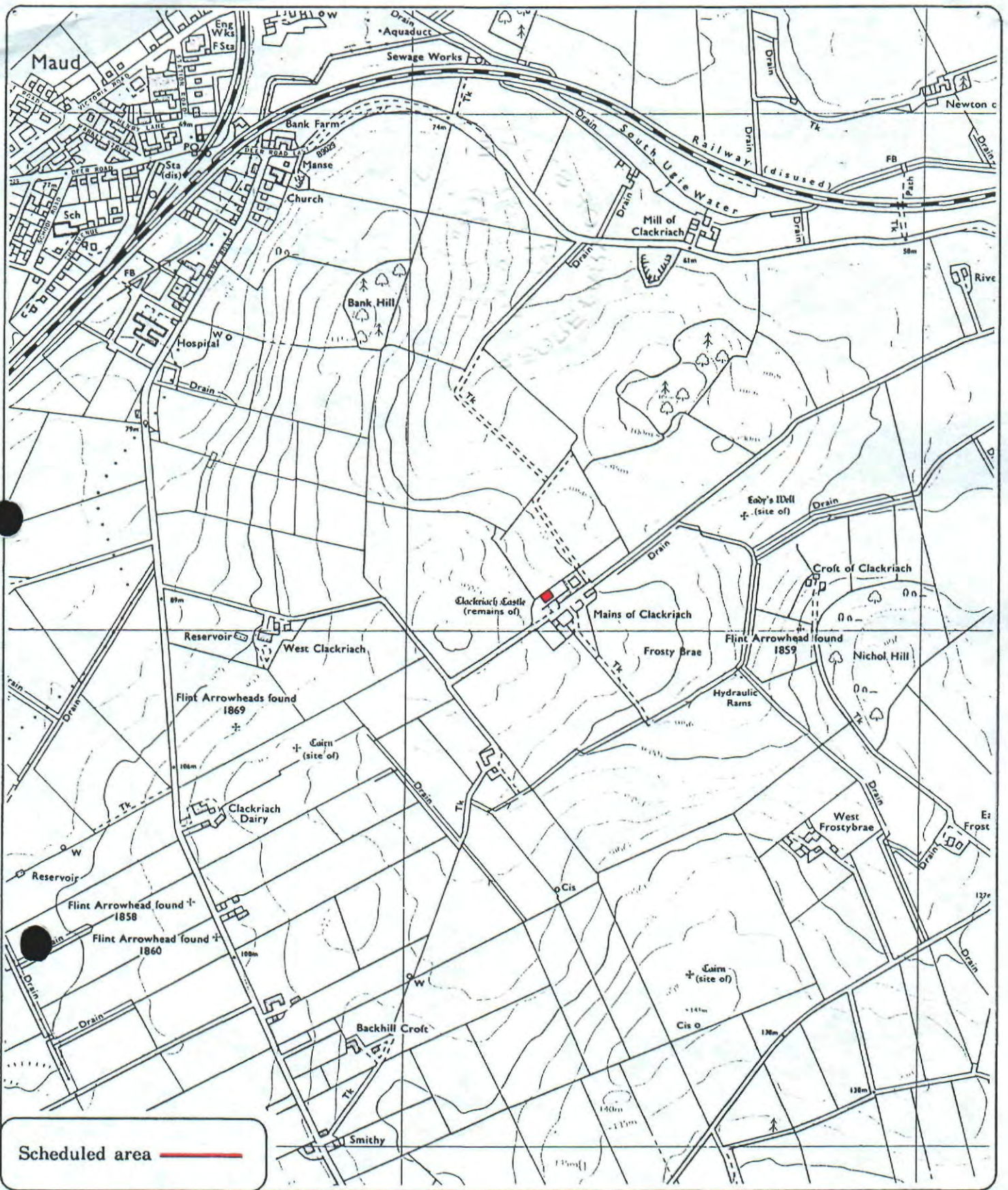
