The monument known as Old Foundry Holm, ironworks comprises the remains of a charcoal and peat-charcoal fired iron-smelting works of the 1730s. The area to be scheduled is irregular in outline, maximum dimensions 380m NW-SE by 140m SW-NE to include all these features and an area around and between them in which evidence associated with their construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Auchinleck and the County of Ayr as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

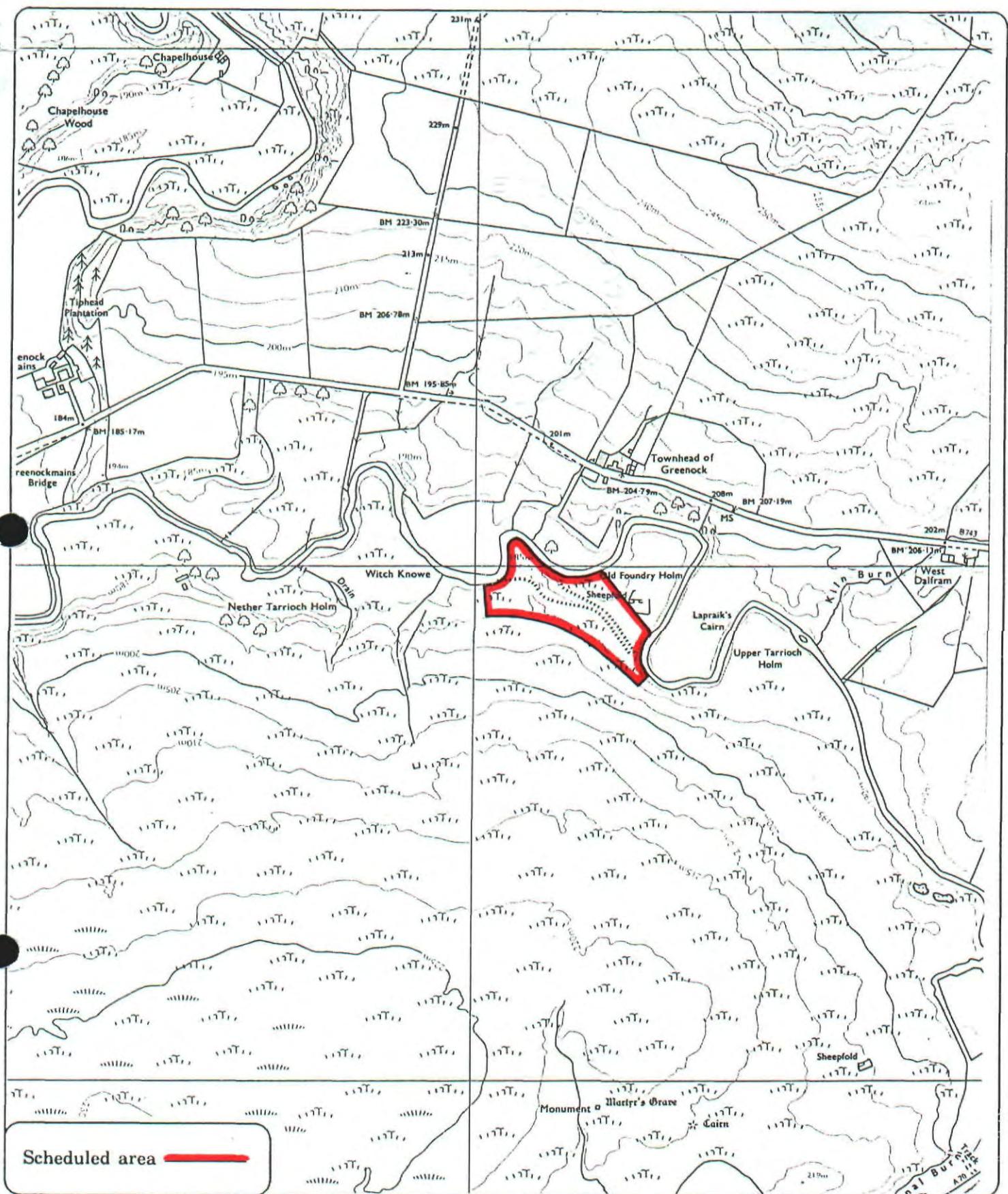
