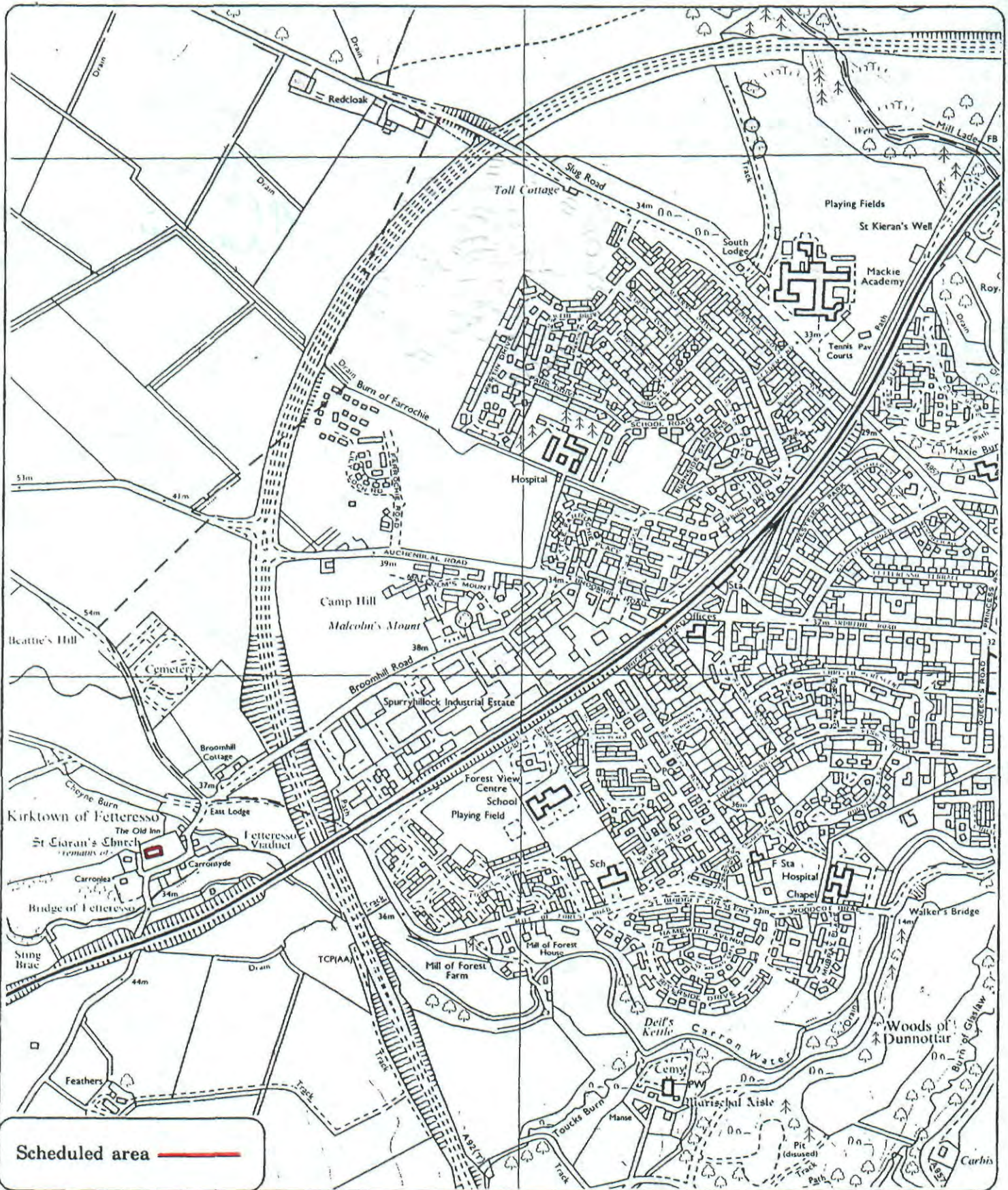
The monument known as St Ciaran's Church, old parish church, Fetteresso comprises the remains of the former parish church of Fetteresso which was dedicated in 1246, and remained in use until the early 19th century. The ruined church is likely to overlie the remains of the church of St Ciaran. The area to be scheduled is rectangular, extending 3m from the exterior walls of the church and measuring a maximum of 32.6m E-W by 17.6m N-S. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Fetteresso and the County of Kincardine as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

Scheduled area —

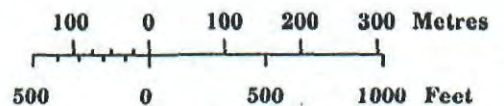
St Ciaran's Church, old parish church, Fetteresso
