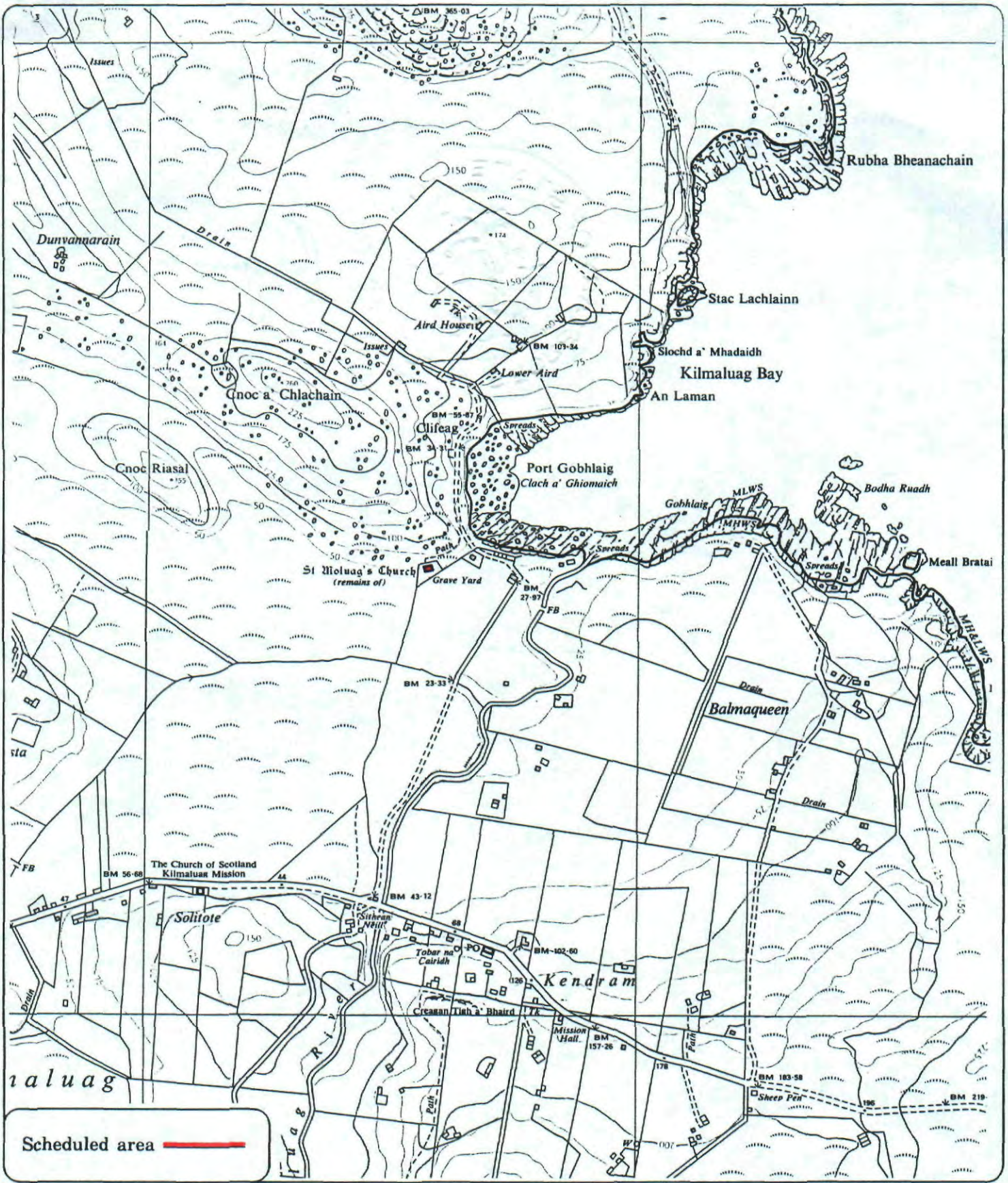
The monument known as St Moluag's Church, Kilmaluag Bay comprises the remains of a church called St Moluag's (Kilmaluag). The area to be scheduled is rectangular, including the area within the church and extending 2m outwith the wall footings, measuring a maximum of 18m E-W by 12m N-S. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilmuir and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

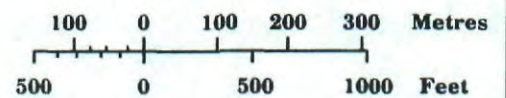
St Moluag's Church, Kilmaluag Bay
