The monument known as Pittulie Castle comprises the remains of Pittulie Castle, a defensive residence which is of sixteenth to seventeenth century date. The area to be scheduled is square, aligned NNW-SSE, with sides measuring a maximum of 35m, to include the castle and an area which is likely to contain related buried features. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Pitsligo and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

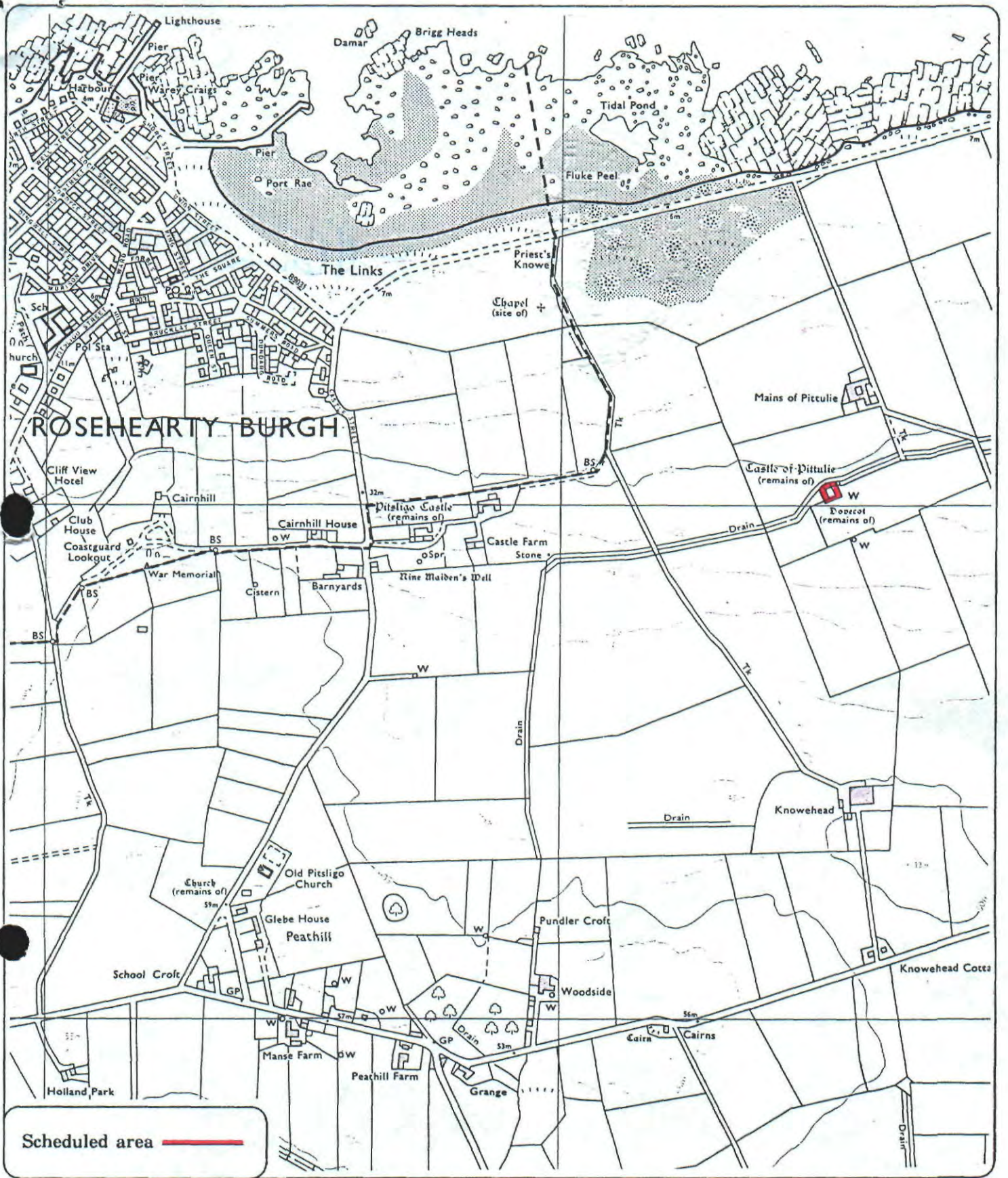

Scheduled area —

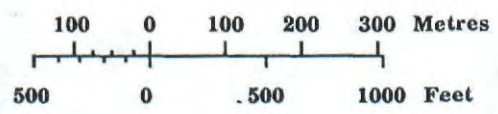
Pittulie Castle
