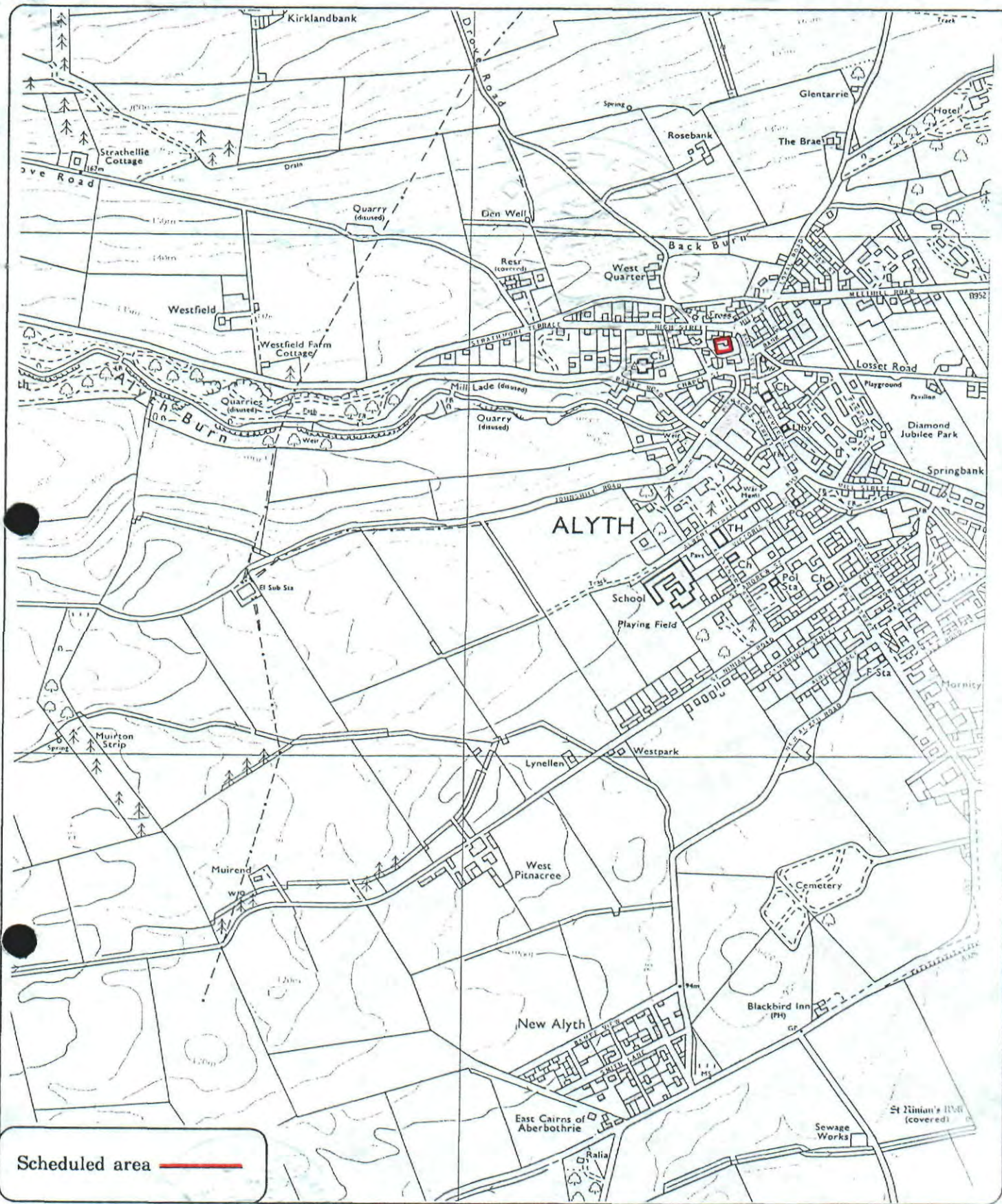

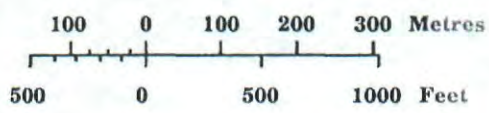
Scheduled area ———
