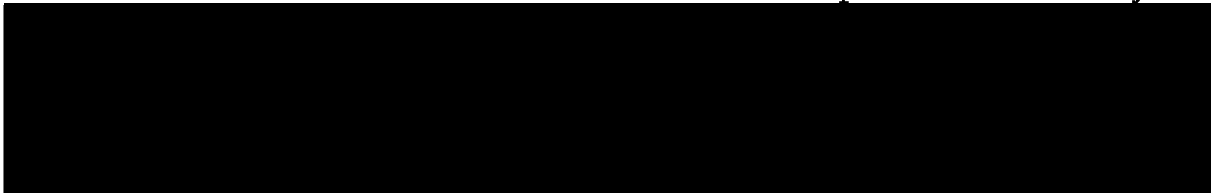

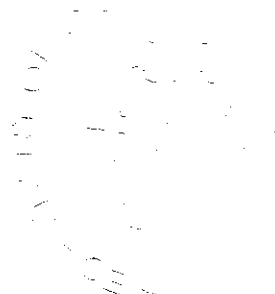
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Auchenlaich, long cairn NE of comprises an extremely substantial long cairn in a low-lying position with higher ground on all sides. The area to be scheduled measures a maximum of 380m NNW-SSE by 55m E-W, to include the long cairn and an area around in which traces of activities associated with its construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Callander and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects



, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

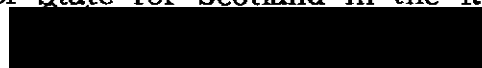

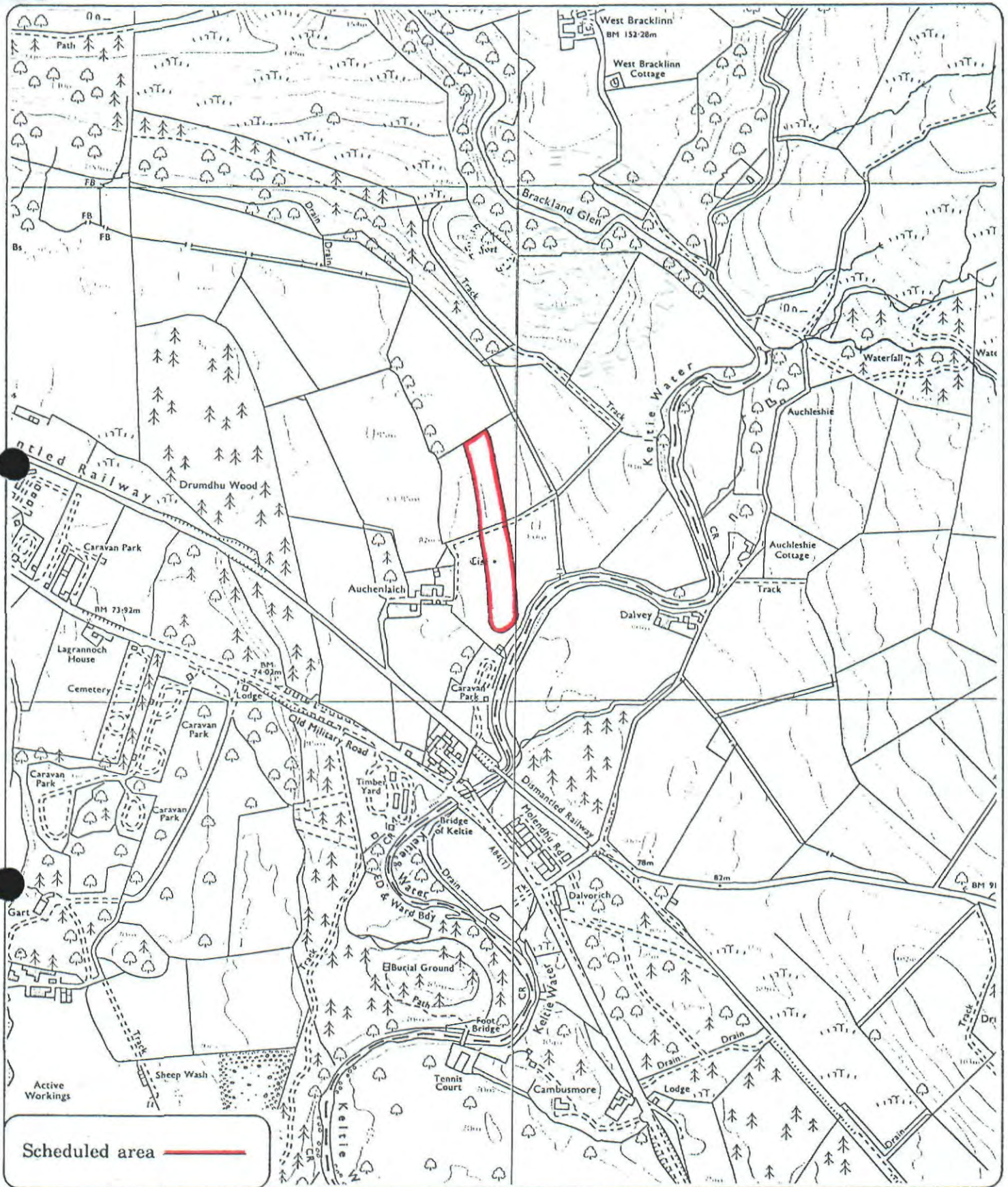

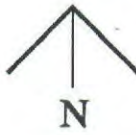

Scheduled area

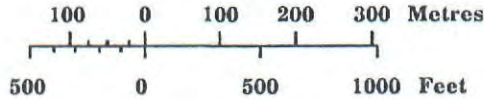
Auchenlaich, long cairn NE of
