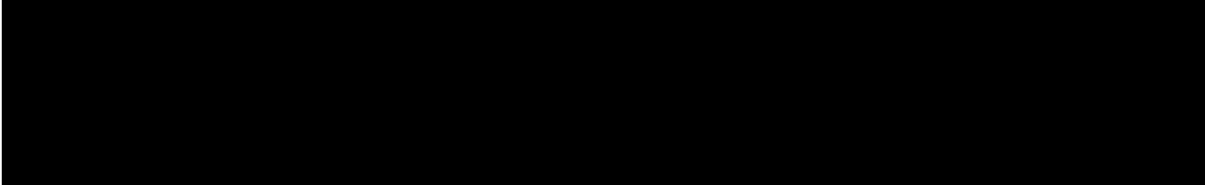

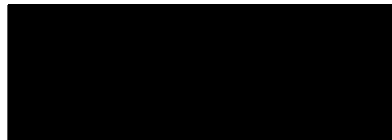
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Auldcaithie Church comprises the roofless ruin of a pre-Reformation chapel. The building appears to have been constructed partly from the remains of an earlier building, as packing material within the walls may contain fragments of late 14th century fabric. The area to be scheduled is rectangular, measuring a maximum of 40m E-W by 35m N-S to include the church and a surrounding area where further features are likely to survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kirkliston and the County of West Lothian as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

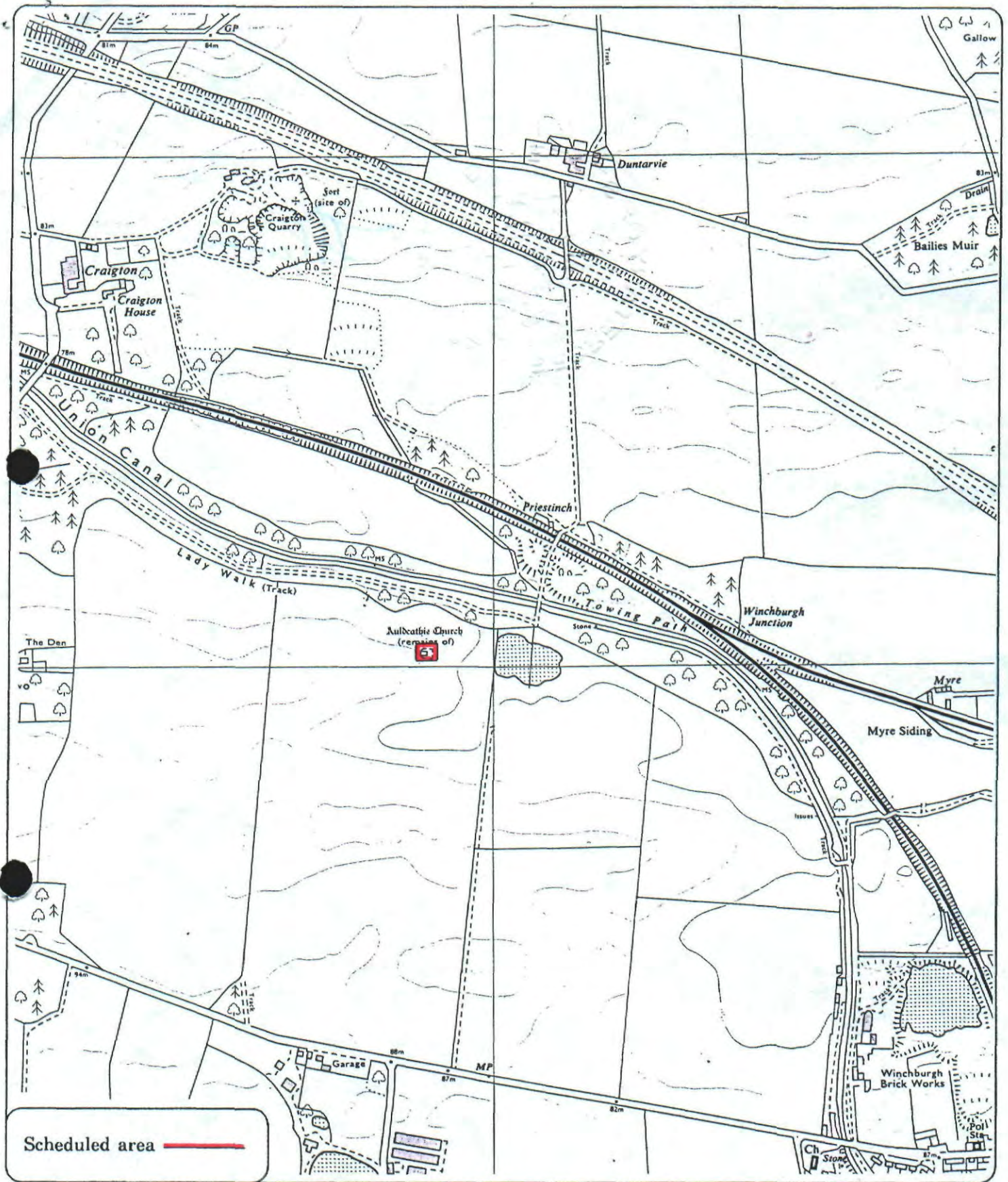

Scheduled area —

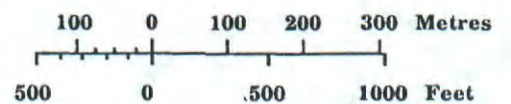
**Auldscathie Church**
