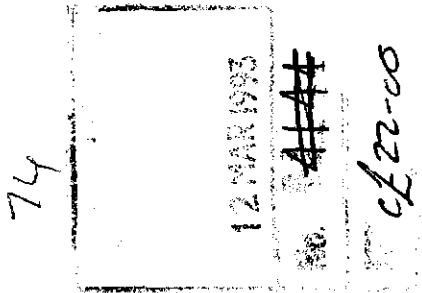

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Kirkforthar House and Dovecot comprises the remains of Kirkforthar House, a 17th century residence which was remodelled during the 18th century, and its associated dovecot. The area to be scheduled is rectangular, measuring a maximum of 80m E-W by 65m N-S, to include the house, dovecot and an area surrounding and between in which further features are likely to survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Markinch and the County of Fife as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which

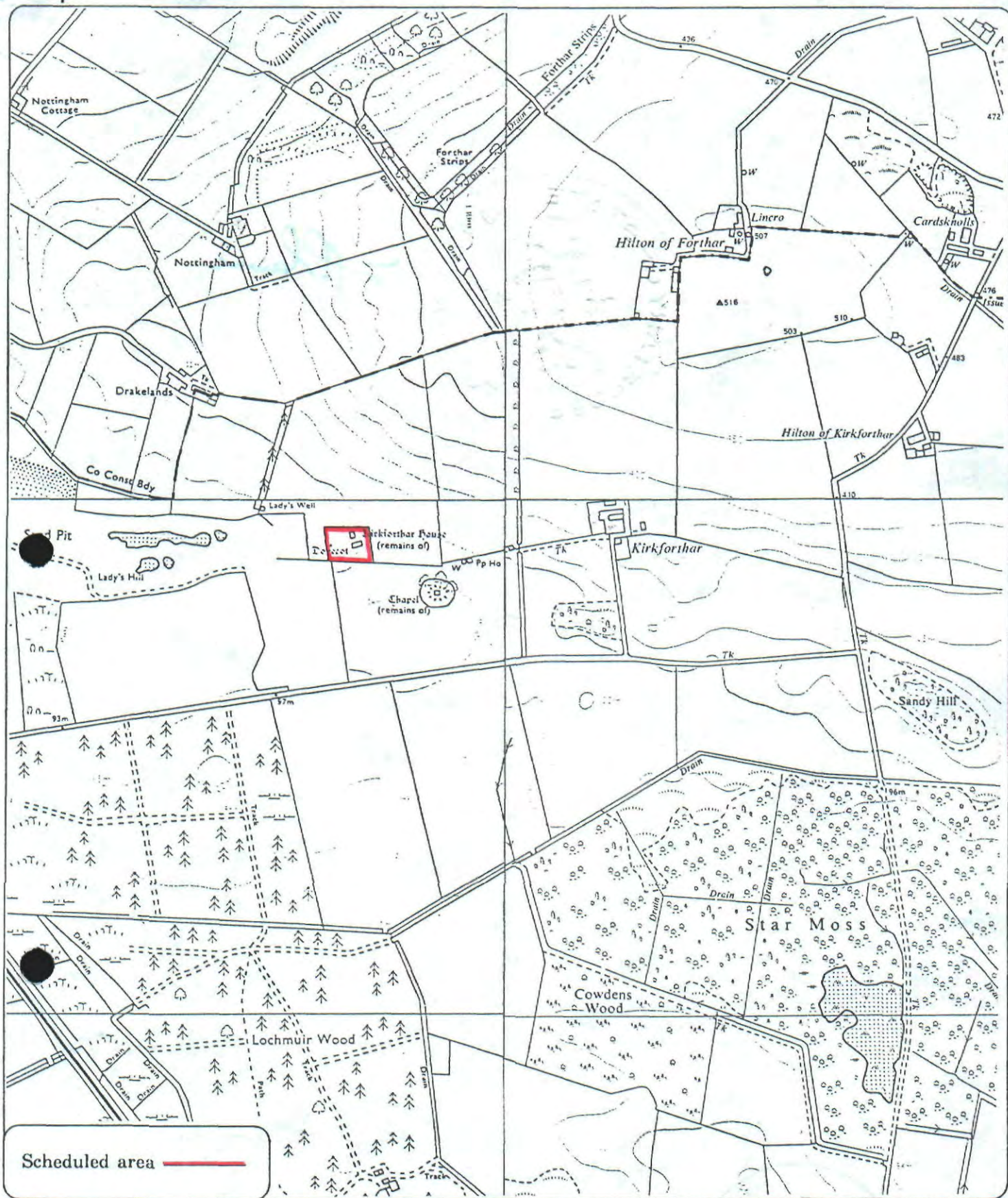
