ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

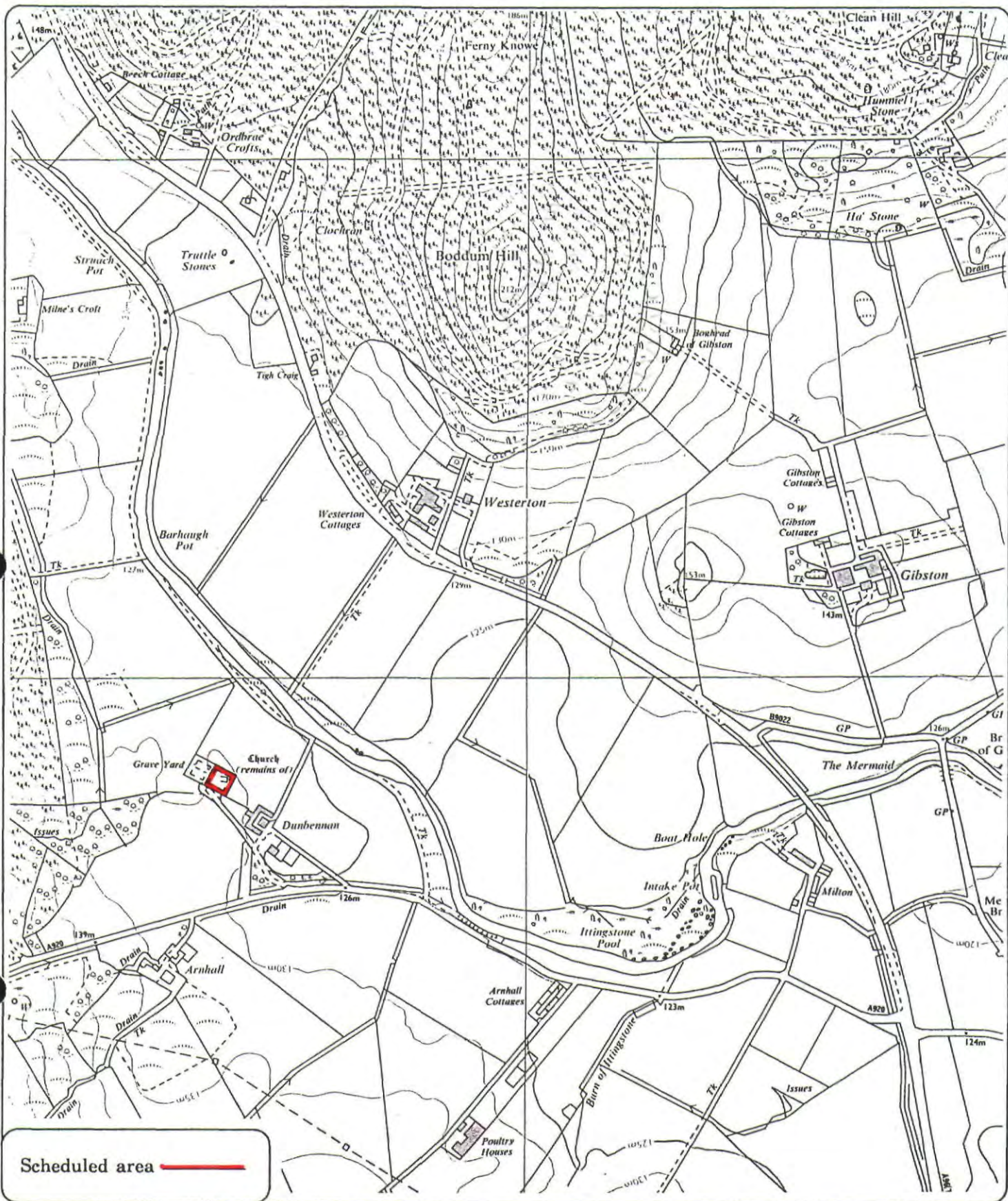
The monument known as Dunbennan Old Church, church and burial ground comprises the remains of the old parish church of Dunbennan. The area to be scheduled is square with sides measuring a maximum of 45m to include the buried remains of the church and the original area of the graveyard. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Huntly and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

Scheduled area —

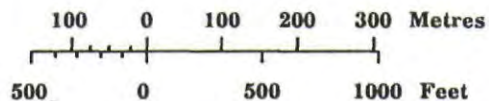
**Dunbennan Old Church,
