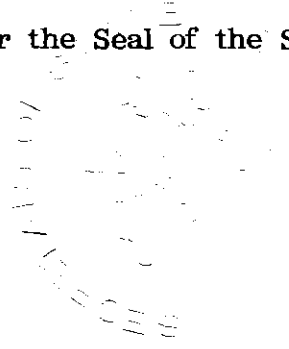

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Kinnoir Old Church, church 550m WSW of Corse of Kinnoir comprises the remains of the old parish church of Kinnoir. The area to be scheduled is rectangular, extending 2m from the exterior of the wall foundations, and measures a maximum of 21m NE-SW by 11m NW-SE. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Huntly and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.
