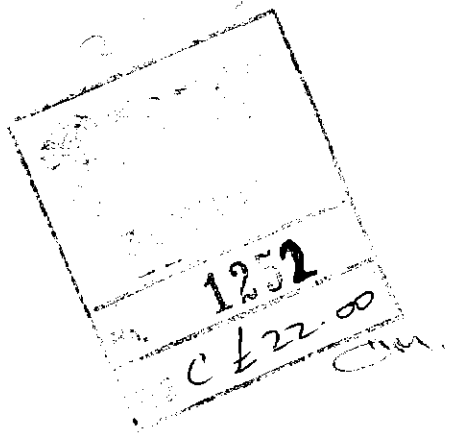

The monument known as Fee Donald Lead Mine, Allt Feith Dhomhnuill, Sunart comprises the underground workings and associated surface remains of an abandoned lead mine. The area to be scheduled is irregular in shape but is approximately 900m by 450m at its widest points. 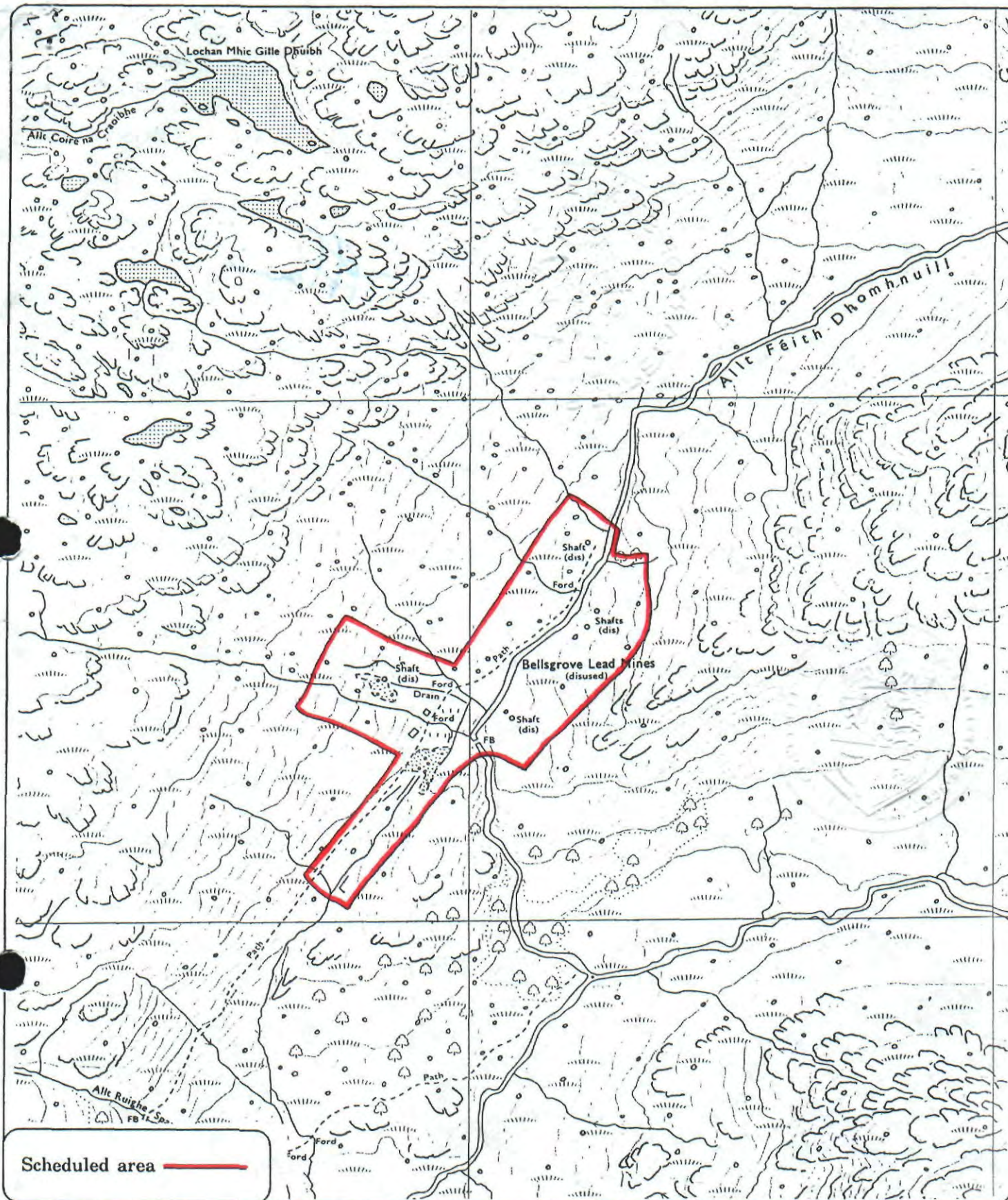

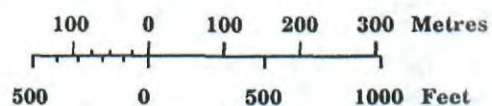
