THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as St Peter's Church, old parish church, Peterhead comprises the remains of St Peter's Church, the original parish church of Peterhead, which is thought to date from the twelfth century. The church is on record from 1218 when it was transferred to the Abbey of Deer from Dunkeld Cathedral. The area to be scheduled is rectangular, measuring a maximum of 36m NW-SE by 13m NE-SW. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Peterhead and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.
