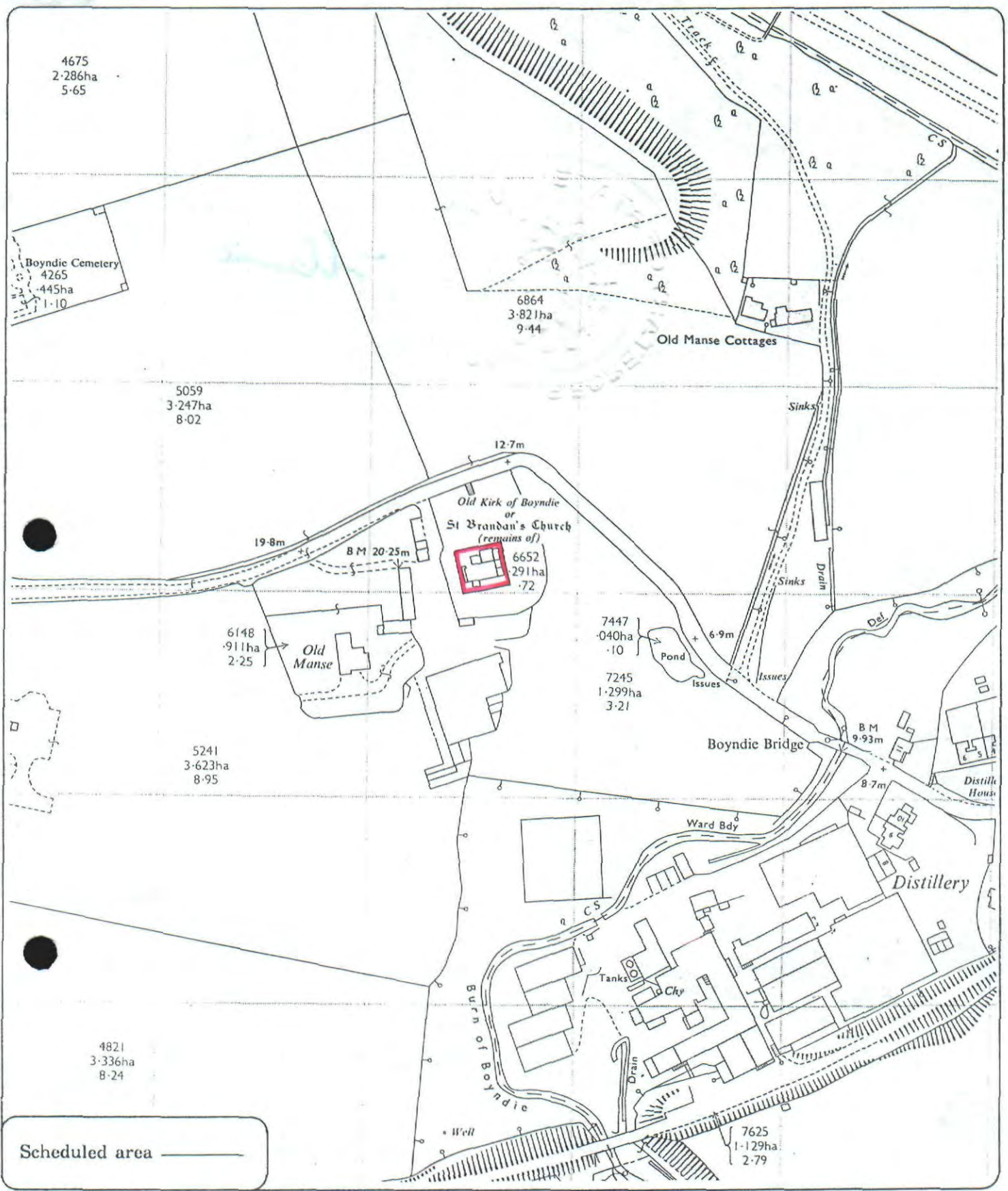
The monument known as Boyndie Old Kirk, church 200m NW of Boyndie Bridge comprises the remains of St Brandan's, the old parish church of Boyndie. The area to be scheduled is rectangular, measuring a maximum of 20m NNW-SSE by 24m ENE-WSW, to include the upstanding portions and the buried foundations. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Boyndie and the County of Banff as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

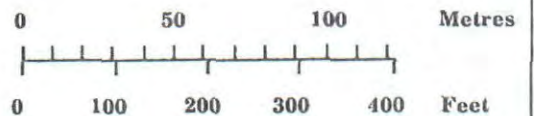
Boyndie Old Kirk, church 200m
