The monument known as Kirkton, old parish church 400m ESE of Kirkton Mains, Bathgate comprises the remains of Bathgate Old Parish Church. The area to be scheduled is rectangular, extending 2m from the exterior walls of the church, measuring a maximum 34.1m E-W by 11.9m N-S. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Bathgate and the County of West Lothian as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

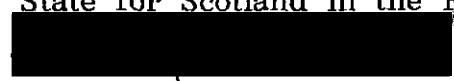

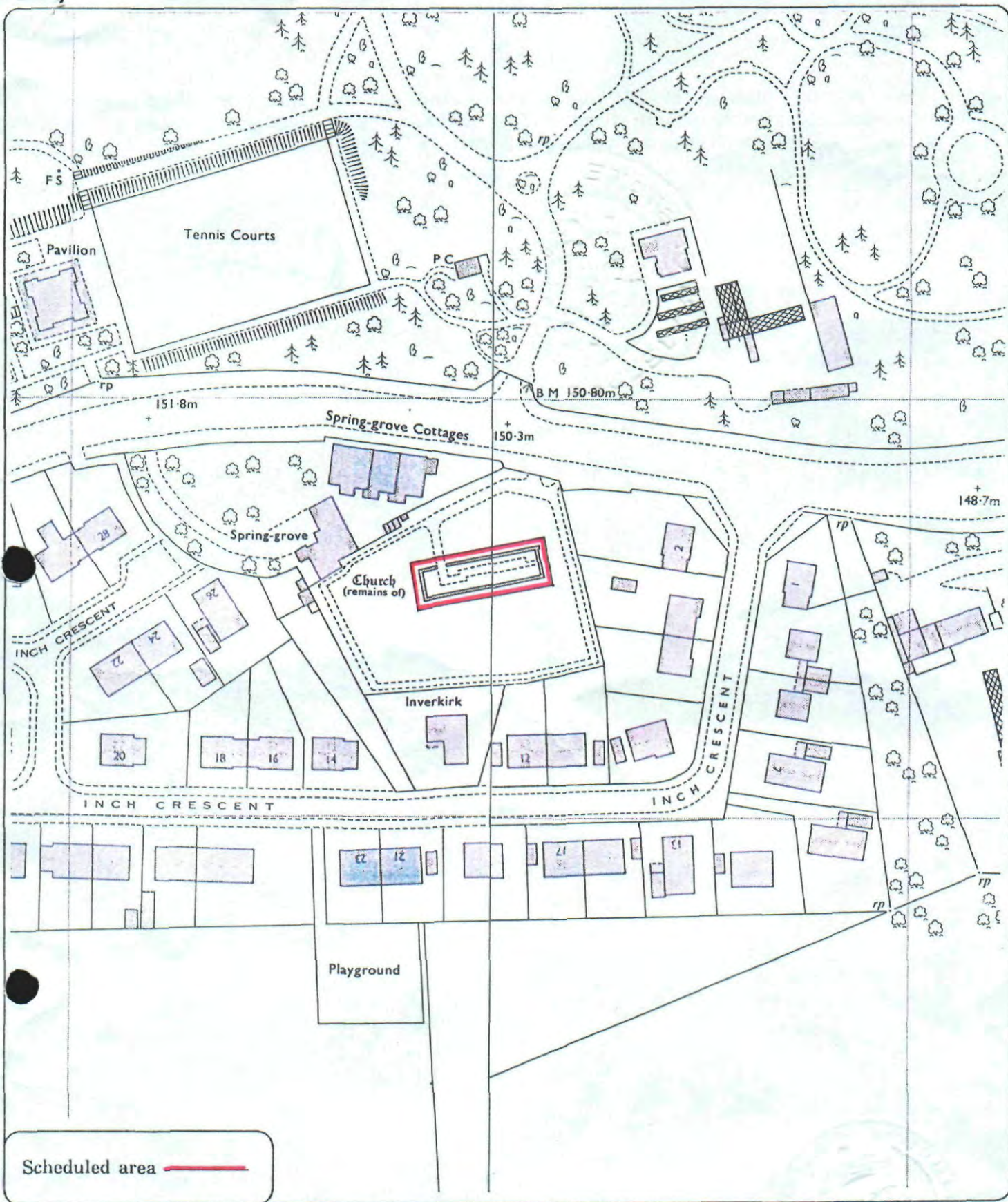

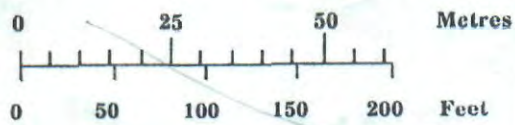
