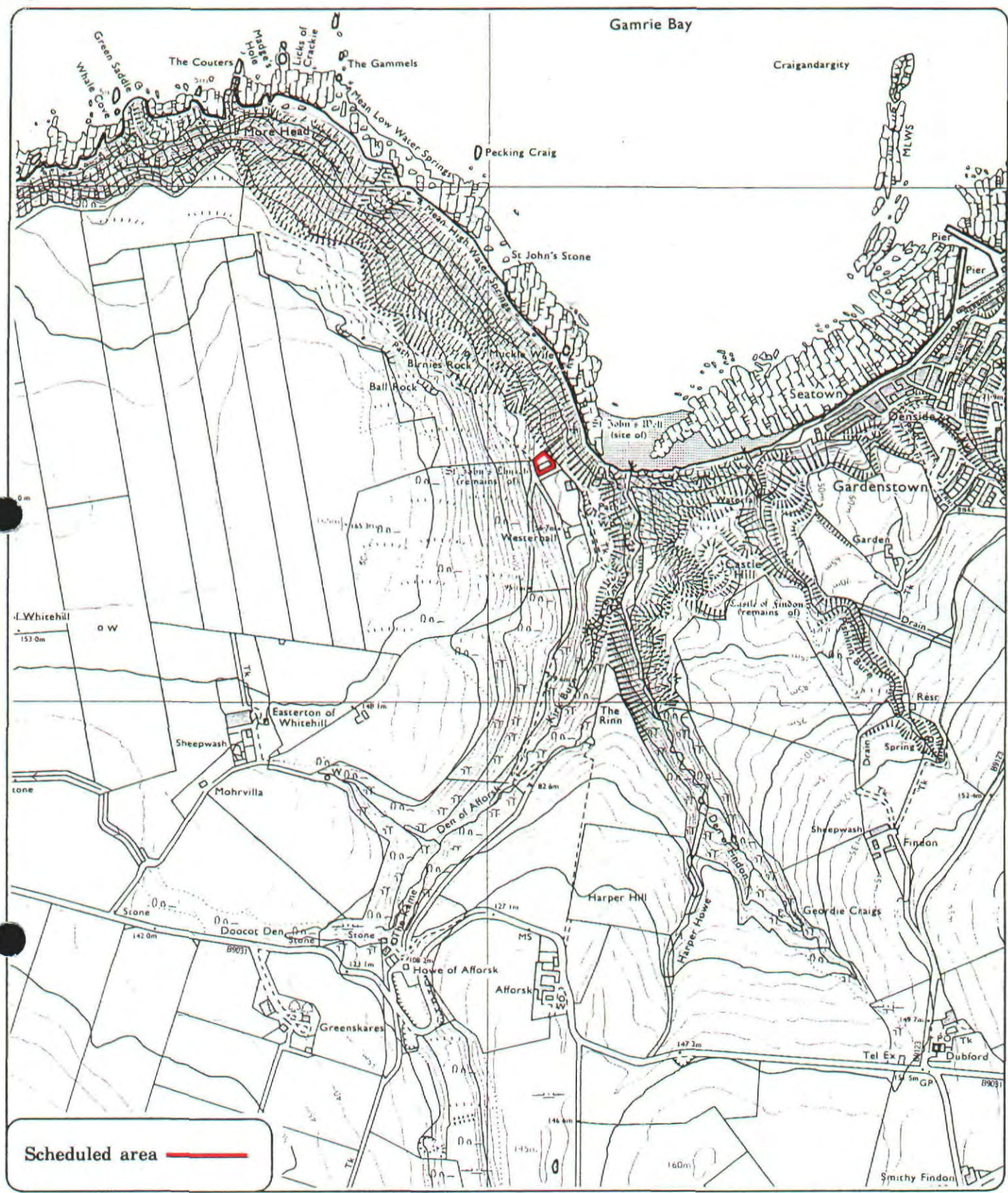
The monument known as St John's Church, old parish church and burial ground, Gamrie comprises the remains of the old parish church and burial ground of Gamrie. The dedication is to St John the Evangelist. The area to be scheduled is irregular, measuring a maximum of 40m E-W by 45m N-S. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Gamrie and the County of Banff as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

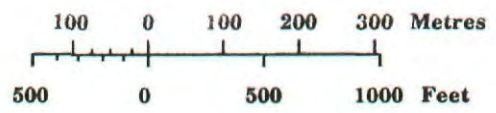
**St. John's Church, old parish church and burial ground, Gamrie**
