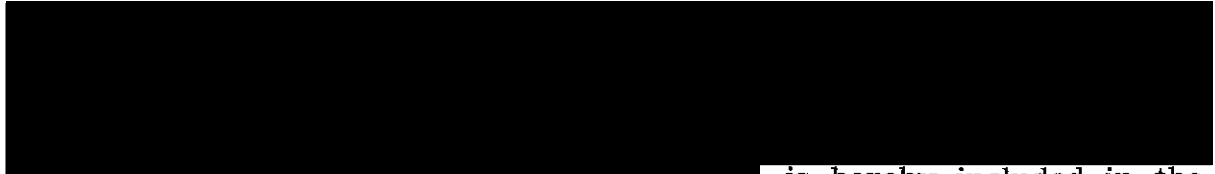

The monument known as Gearraidh na h-Airde Moire, shielings, Loch Resort comprises the remains of a group of shieling huts used as a base for seasonal pasturing of livestock. The area to be scheduled is circular, 70m in diameter, to include the shielings and an area between and around in which further associated remains may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Uig and the County of Ross and Cromarty as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

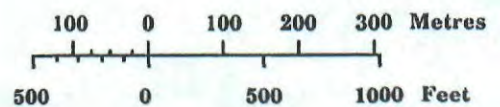
