ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Newton, pit alignment 500m E of comprises part of a pit alignment, probably an agricultural boundary of prehistoric date, represented by cropmarks visible on oblique aerial photographs. The area to be scheduled encompasses the visible pits together with an area around them in which traces of associated activity may be expected to survive. The area is irregular in shape with maximum dimensions of 50m N-S by 30m E-W. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Inveresk and the County of Midlothian as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the Town and lands of Castlesteads in the Parishes of Newton and Inveresk

is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

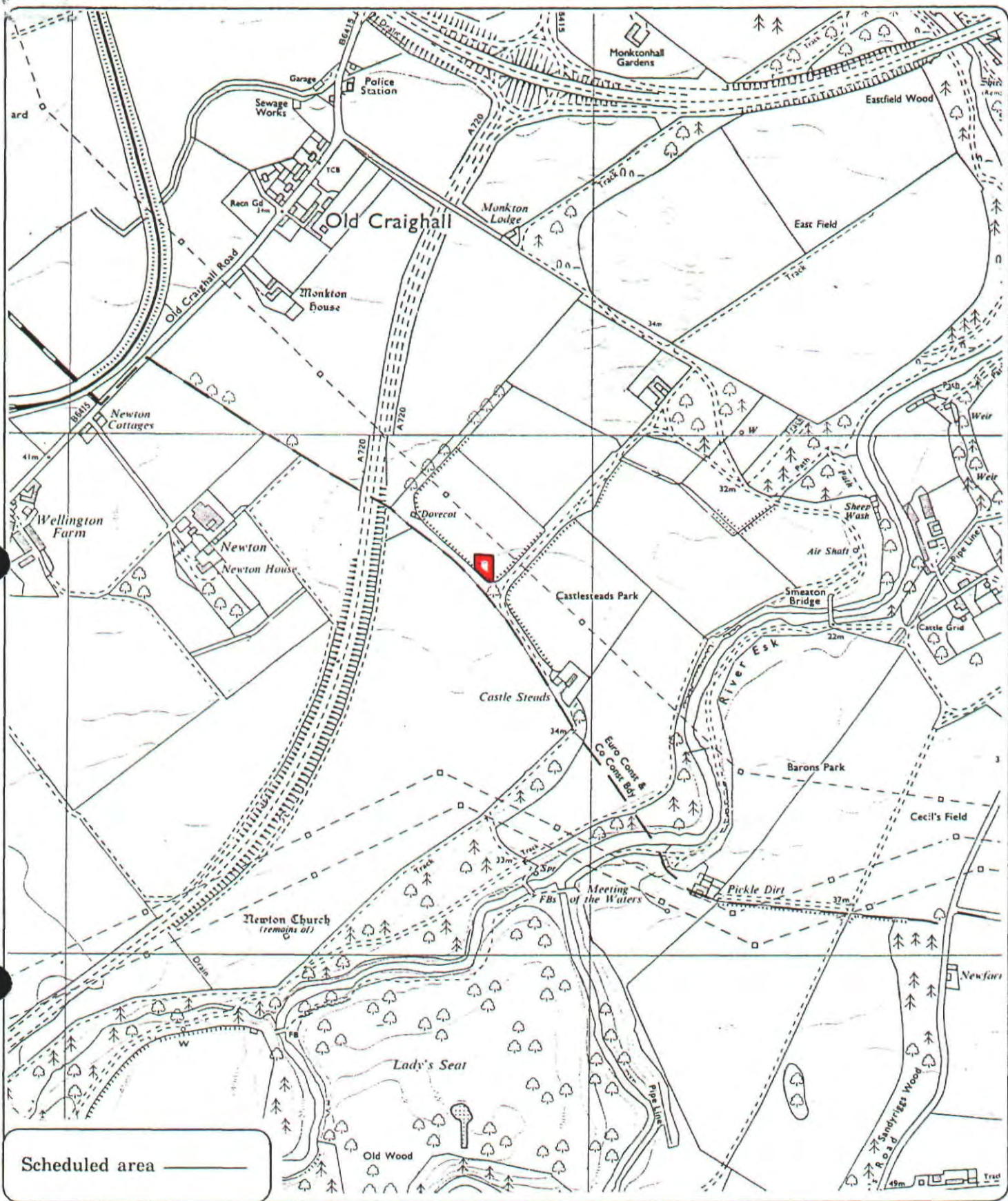

Scheduled area —

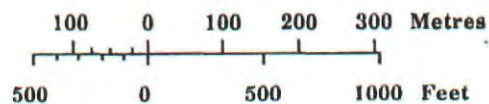
Newton, pit alignment 500m E of
