ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Castlesteads Park, ring ditches comprises the remains of two ring ditches, representing the remains of prehistoric houses, which are visible as cropmarks on oblique aerial photographs. The area to be scheduled encompasses the visible cropmark features together with an area around them in which traces of contemporary activity may survive. It is rectilinear in shape measuring 210m NW-SE by 130m NE-SW. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Inveresk and the County of Midlothian as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the Town and Lands of Castlesteads in the Parish of Newton [REDACTED]

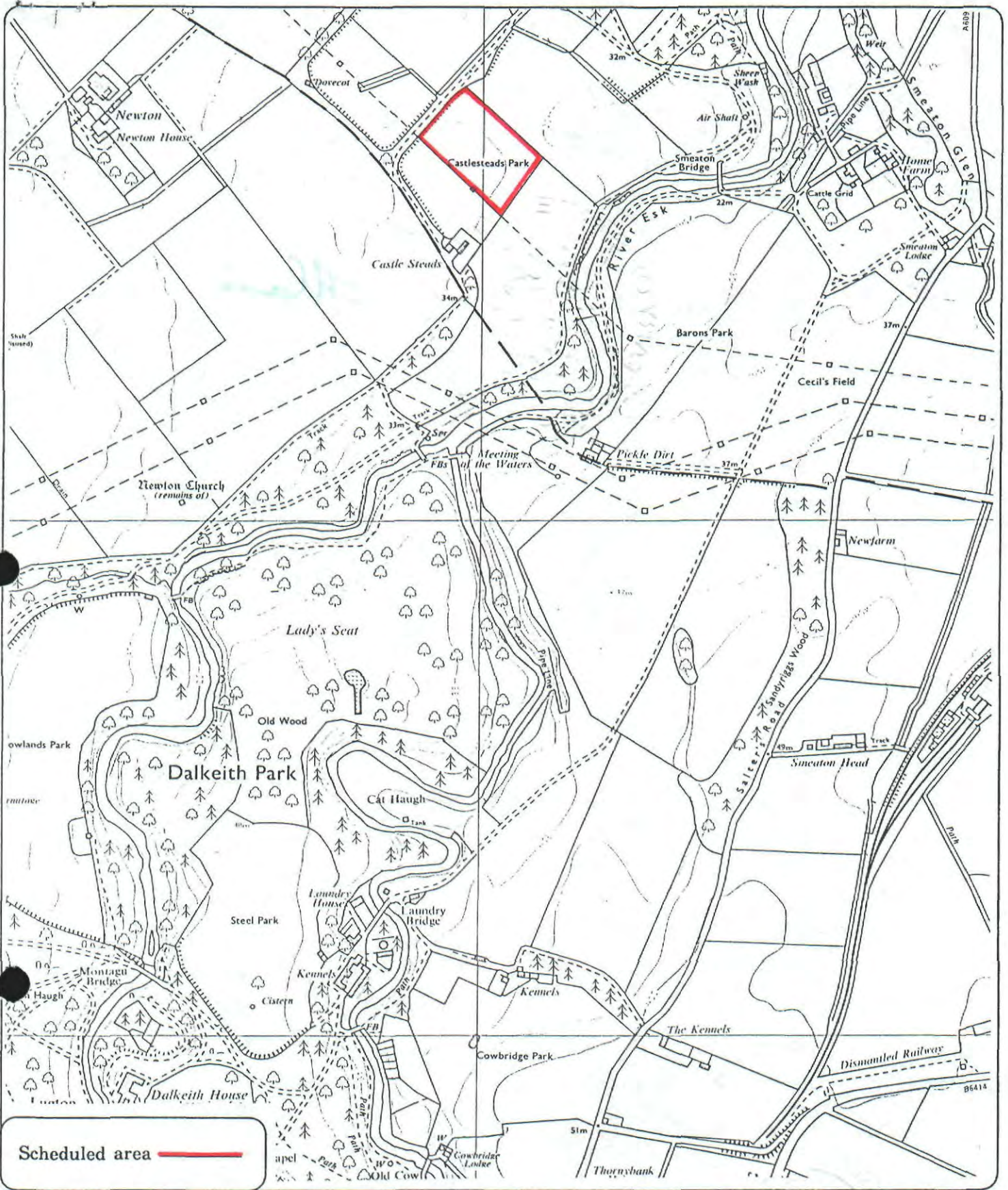

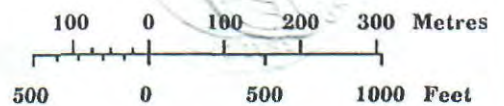
Castlesteads Park, ring ditches
