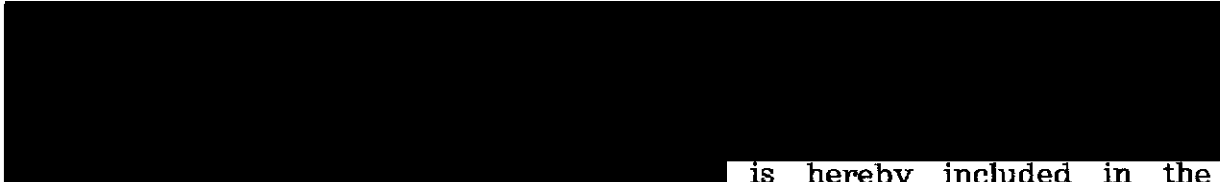

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Both a'Chlair Bhig, beehive shielings comprises of a shieling site which may have been in use since early medieval times. The shieling supports a group of temporary residences and associated structures. The area to be scheduled is rectangular and measures a maximum of 180m NW-SE by 90m NE-SW to include the whole shieling site. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Harris and the Counties of Inverness and Ross and Cromarty as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the

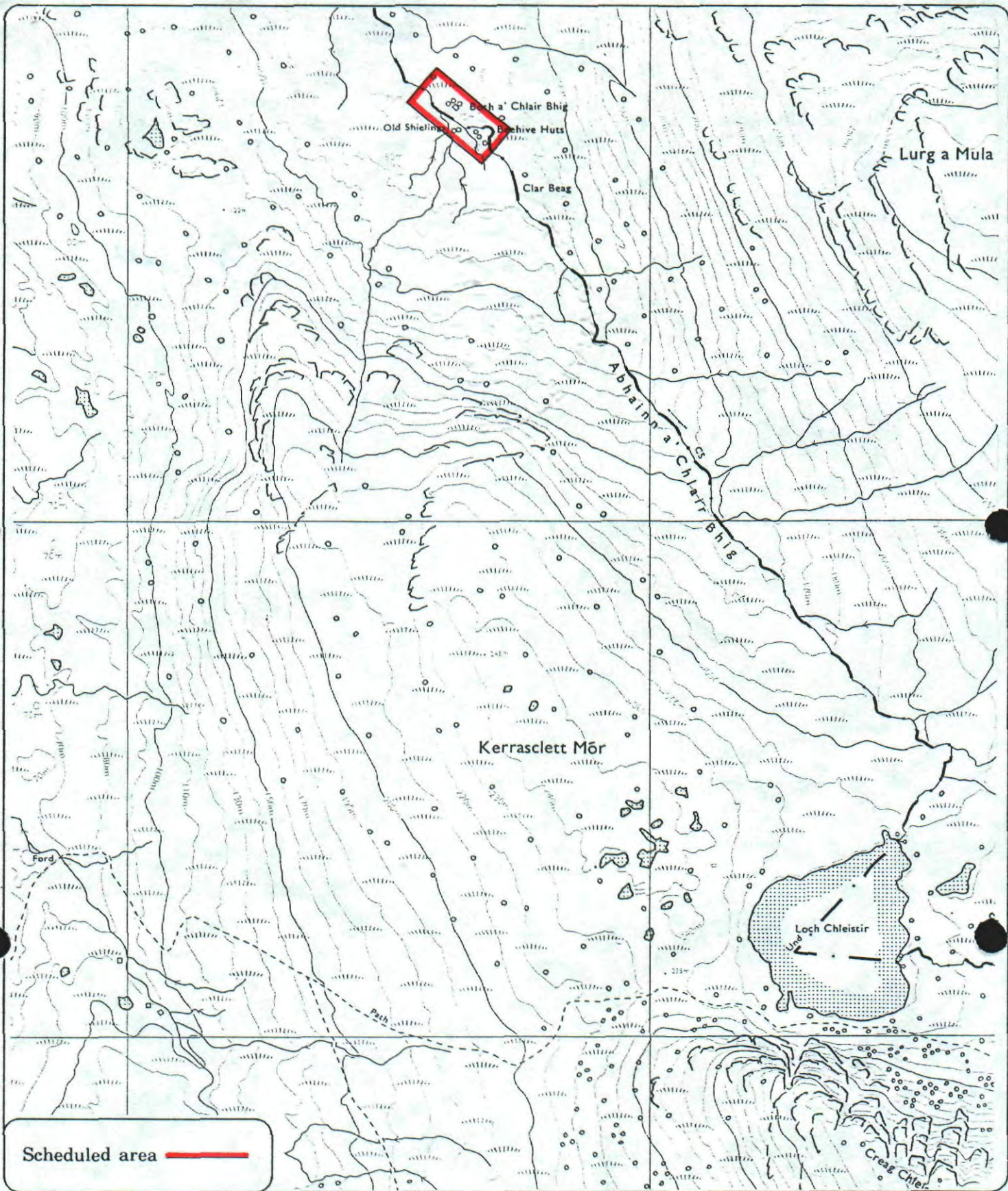

Scheduled area

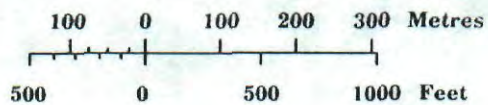
