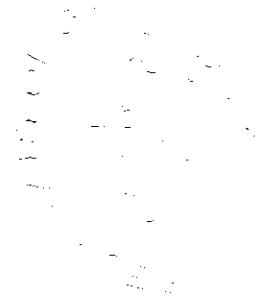

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Setter, chambered cairn 470m NE of, Seli Voe comprises the remains of a prehistoric chambered burial cairn. The area to be scheduled is circular, 60m in diameter, to include the cairn, the top of the spur on which it stands and an area around in which evidence relating to its construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Sandsting and the County of Shetland as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

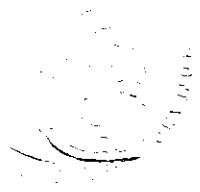

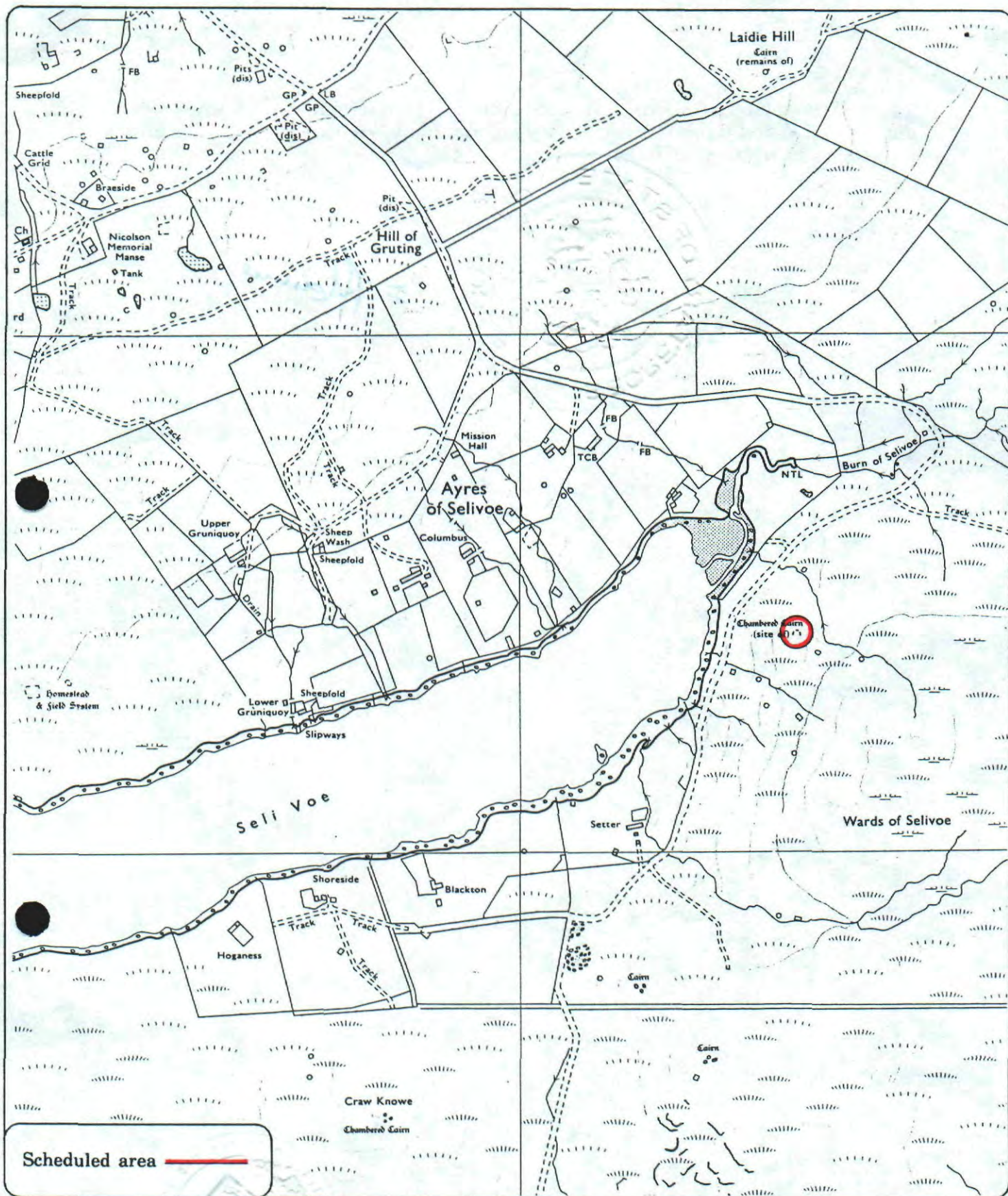

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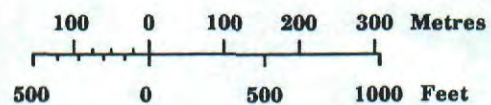
