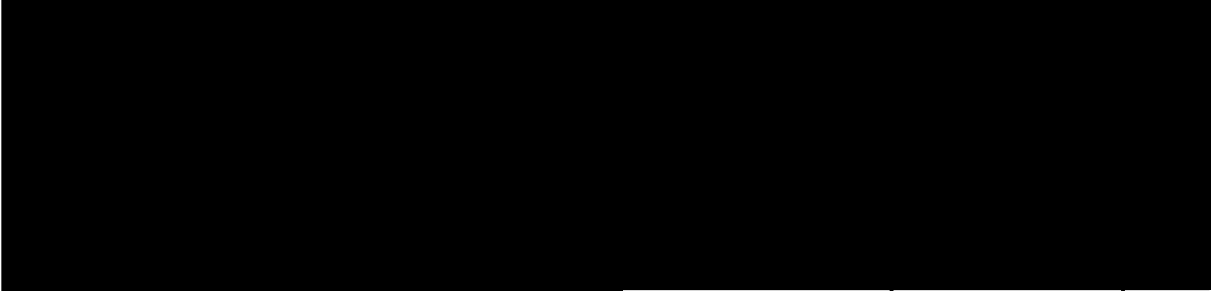

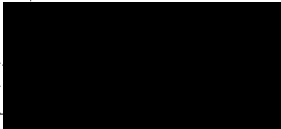

The monument known as Newton, pit alignment 150m NE of comprises part of a pit alignment of prehistoric date, represented by cropmarks visible on oblique aerial photographs. The area to be scheduled encompasses the visible features together with an area around in which traces of associated activity may be expected to survive. The area to be scheduled is bounded on the S by the boundary between East Lothian and Midlothian. The area measures a maximum of 320m N-S by 60m E-W. 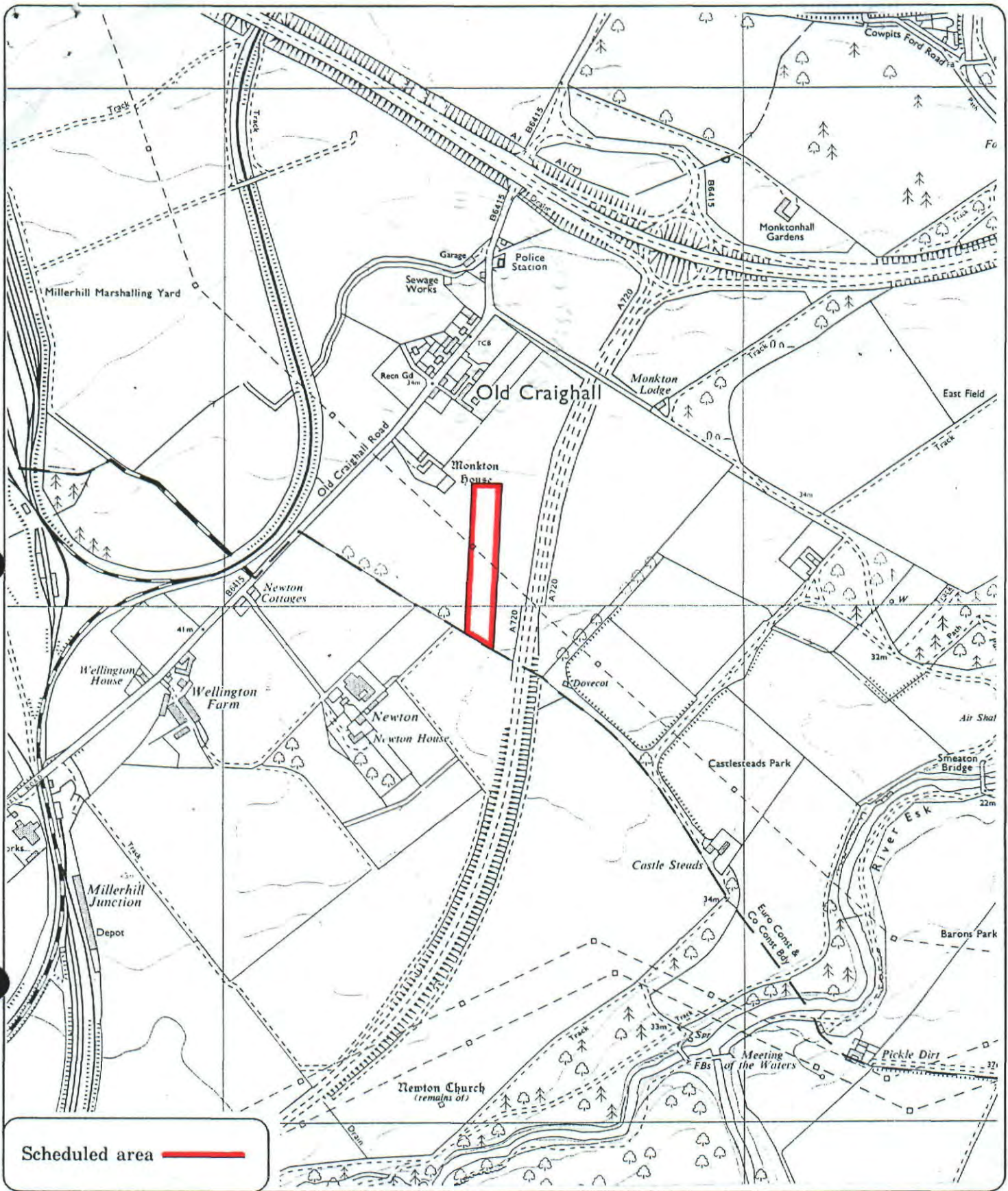

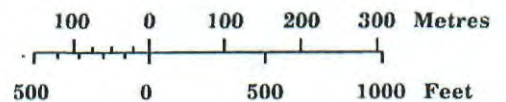
Newton, pit alignment 150m NE
