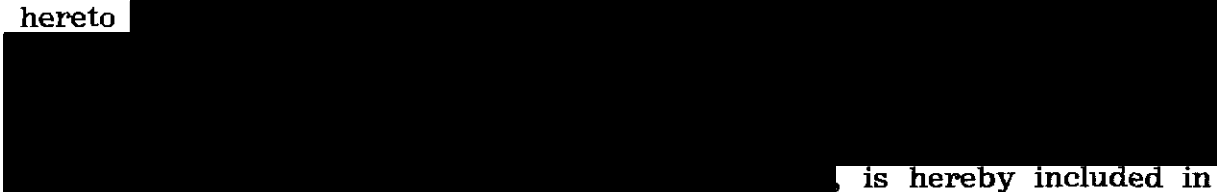

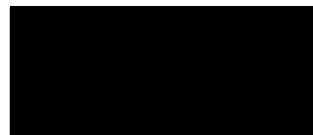
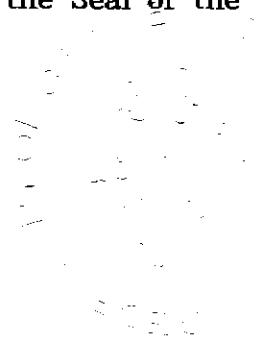
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Asleisk Castle comprises the remains of the Castle of Asleisk which probably date from the late 16th century. The area to be scheduled is rectangular measuring a maximum of 25m E-W by 13m N-S, but excluding the modern farm buildings on the S and W. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Alves and the County of Moray as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

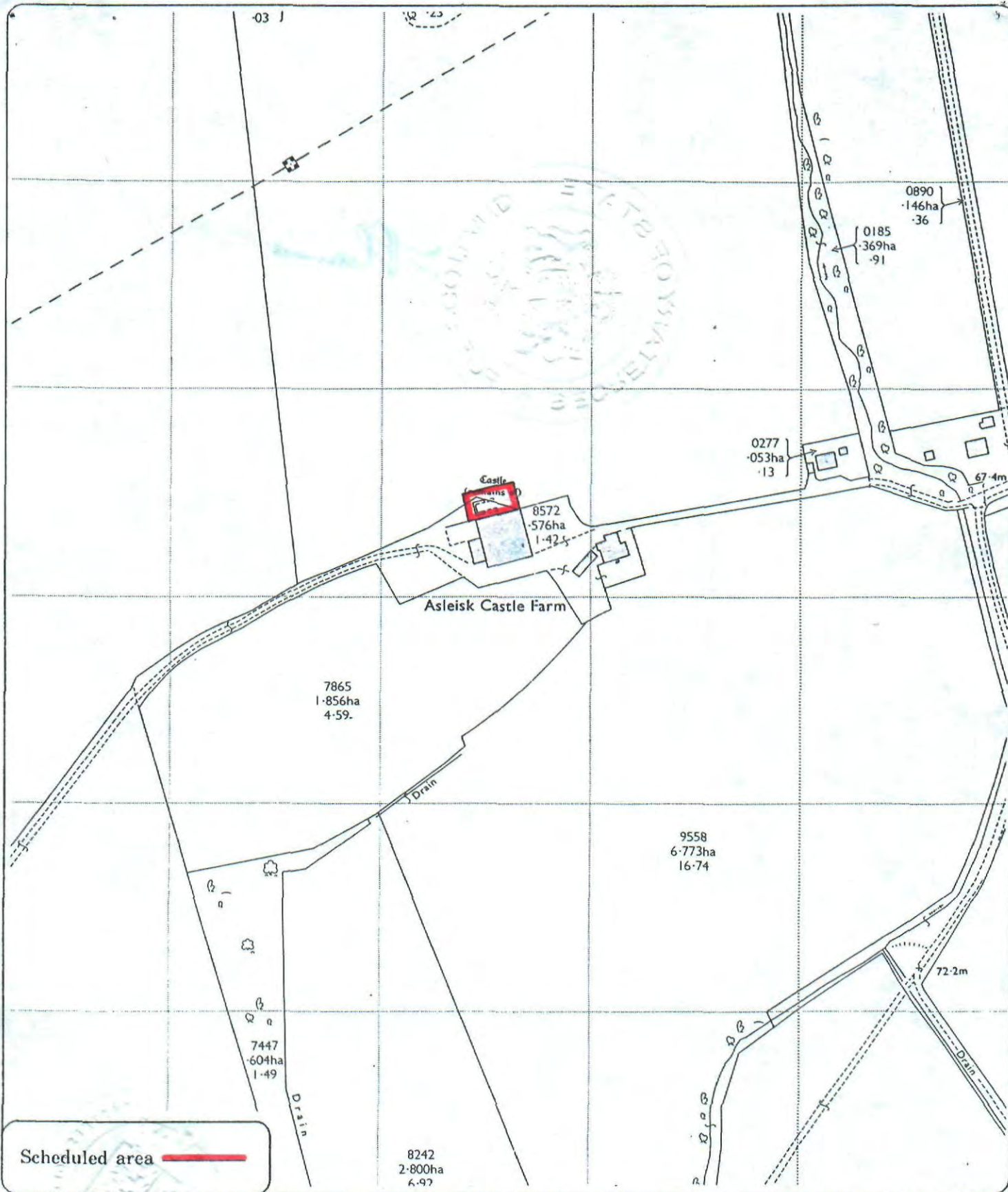

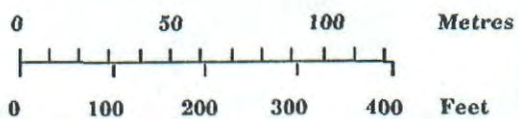
