ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Finlaggan, standing stones 190m E of and standing stone 80m WSW of comprises two elements. A single standing stone situated in the NW corner of a field of improved pasture 80m WSW of Finlaggan farmsteading, and two recumbent stones on a slight ridge in a largely improved field 190m to the E of the farm. The areas to be scheduled measure 20m in diameter (centred on NR39276856) and 30m from NW to SE by 20m transversely (centred on NR39576853) to include the stones and an area around in which evidence associated with their construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Killarow and Kilmeny and the County of Argyll as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and
