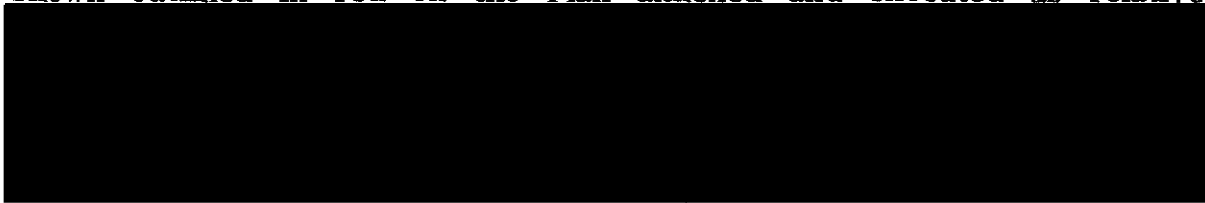

The monument known as Gro Ghot, cairn and shieling, Usinish comprises the remains of a prehistoric burial cairn, into which has been set a relatively recent shieling hut. The area to be scheduled is circular, 32m in diameter, to include the cairn and shieling and an area around in which traces of their construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of South Uist and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative

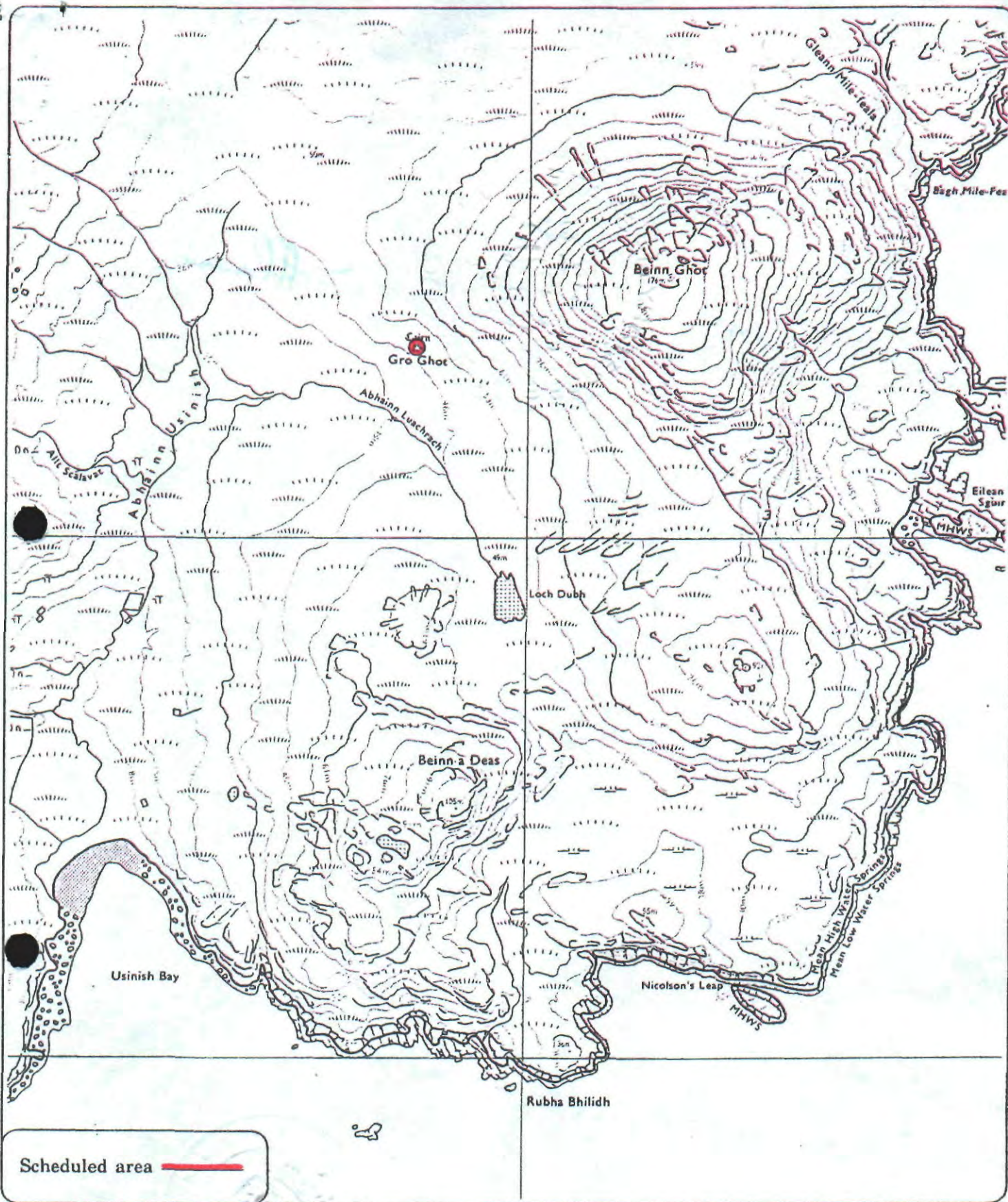
