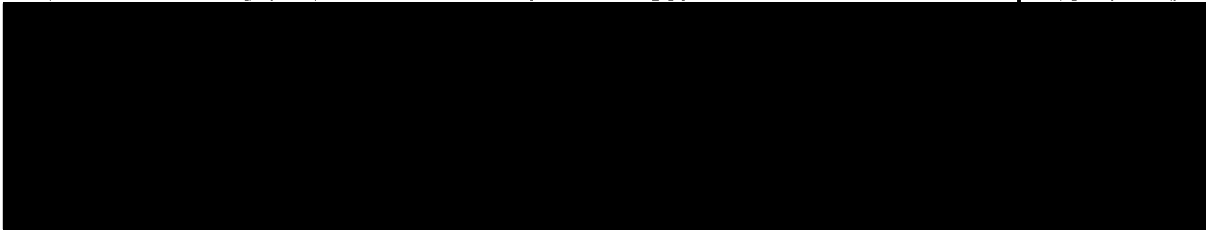

The monument known as Uneval, souterrain and shielings E of comprises the remains of a souterrain beside a large settlement mound, on and about which are several shielings. It is located on gently-sloping ground to the E of Uneval and N of the NW arm of Loch Huna. The area to be scheduled is rectangular, 70m E-W by 50m N-S, to include the souterrain, mound and shielings. The monument, which lies in the Parish of North Uist and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the

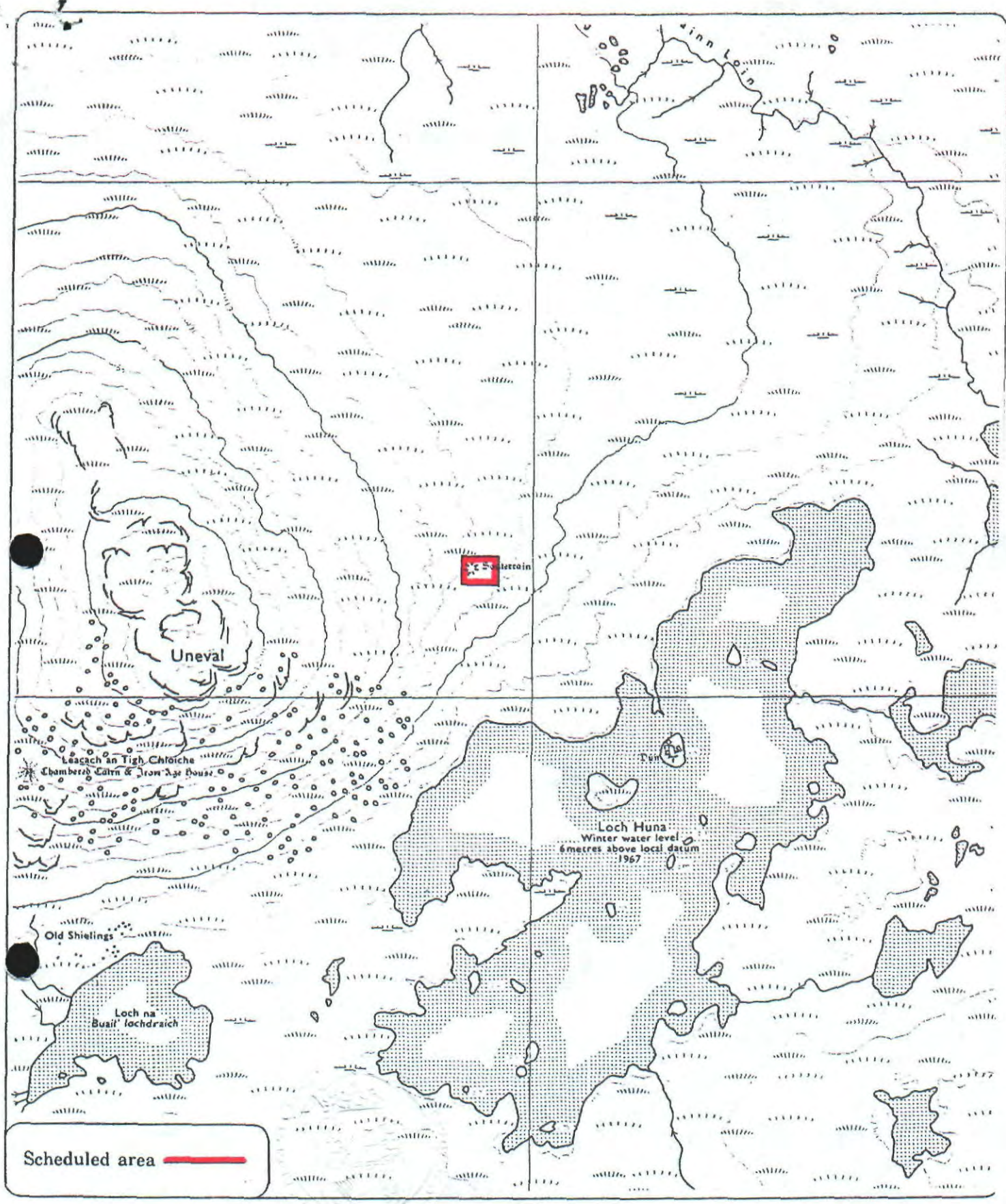


