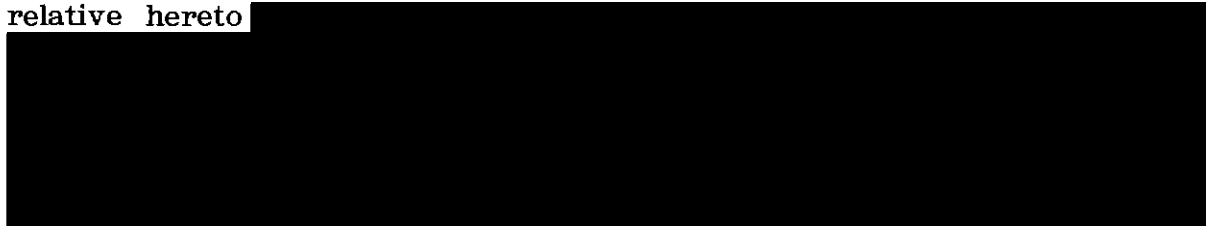

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Tigh Talamhant, souterrain W of Loch Hacklett comprises a souterrain, a prehistoric store-house or hiding place, situated on the W shore of Loch Hacklett. The area to be scheduled consists of a small cliffed promontory, at the foot of which the souterrain is situated and into which it runs. The area is irregular on plan, measuring at maximum 60m N-S by 40m E-W, to include the souterrain, ruined structure and an area around in which further remains may lie concealed. The monument, which lies in the Parish of North Uist and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

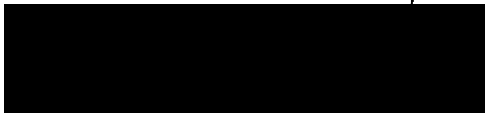
