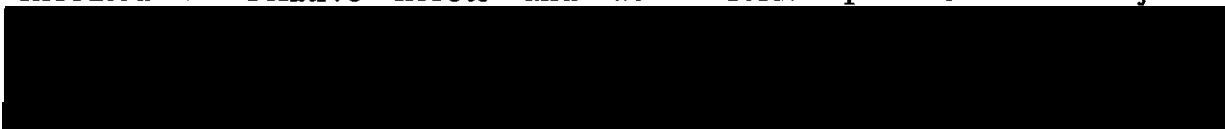

The monument known as Altyre, old parish church comprises the remains of the old parish church of Altyre which date from the beginning of the 14th century. The area to be scheduled is rectangular, extending 5m from the exterior walls of the church and measuring a maximum of 28.65m E-W by 19m N-S. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Rafford and the County of Moray as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

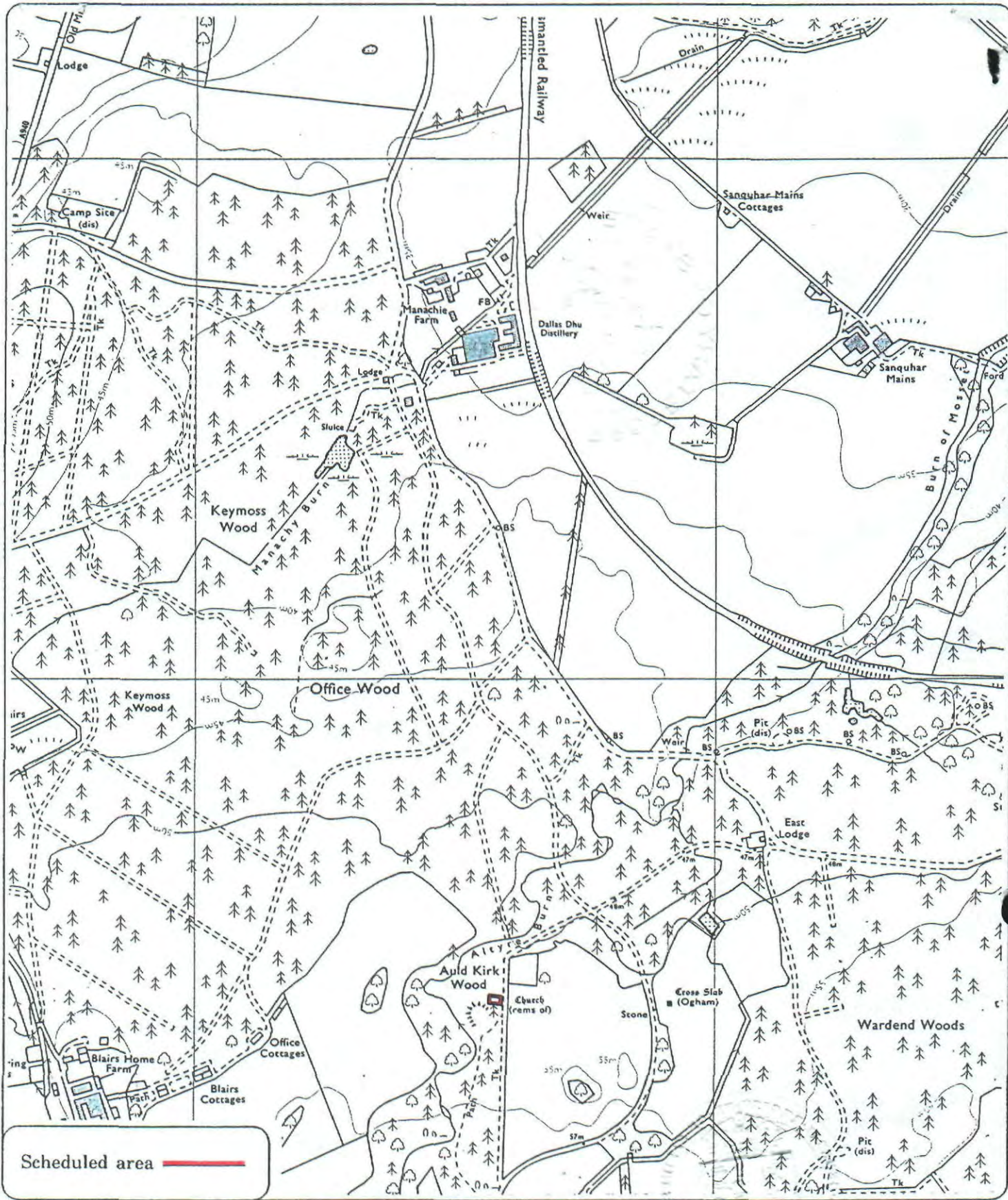
